Road Traffic Acts

THE A78 TRUNK ROAD

(INVERKIP ROAD, GREENOCK) (IBM EASTERN CAR PARK) (PROHIBITION OF SPECIFIED TURNS) ORDER 1999

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd January 1999 the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1(1) as read with sections 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 made the above Order.

A copy of the Order as made, and of the relevant plan, may be inspected free of charge until 5th March 1999 during normal working hours at the offices of The Scottish Office Development Department, National Roads Directorate, Victoria Quay, Edinburgh, EH6 6QQ; and Inverclyde Council Transportation and Roads Department, 20 Pottery Street, Greenock, PA15 2UH.

The effect of the Order is as described in the Notice of the proposal as published in *The Greenock Telegraph* and *The Edinburgh Gazette* on 13th November 1998, and comes into force on 1st February 1999.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from 22nd January 1999 apply to the Court of Session for that purpose.
