#### THE A90 (M90) TRUNK ROAD (INCHMICHAEL INTERCHANGE) (SIDE ROADS) (VARIATION) ORDER 1999

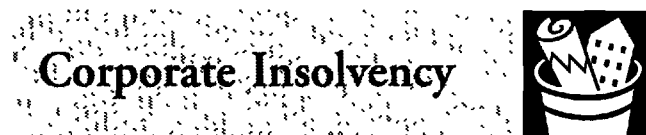
