KINTORE - WAITING RESTRICTIONS

Aberdeenshire Council proposes to make "The Aberdeenshire Council (Various Streets, Kintore) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1999" in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

ROTHIENORMAN - 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT AND TRAFFIC CALMING

Aberdeenshire Council proposes to make "The Aberdeenshire Council (B9001 Rothienorman - Fergie Road at Rothienorman) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 1999" under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the order will be to prohibit any person from driving at a speed exceeding 40 mph on that length of the Rothienorman to Fergie road (B9001) from a point 215 metres south of its junction with Smithy Road southwards for 660 metres or thereby ie a 40mph speed limit will be introduced at the south approach to Rothienorman from the 30 mph speed limit southwards for 660 metres. It is also proposed to construct a "village gateway" in the form of enhanced signing and carriageway markings.
