- b. An Order under section 12(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 to provide for the construction of new side roads, the improvement of certain existing roads to form new and improved connections in relation to the trunk road and the stopping up of various existing roads.

#### MIDDLEBANK TO INCHMARTINE

The Scottish Ministers hereby give notice that they have made the following Order in connection with the improvement of the existing A90 (M90) Trunk Road between Middlebank and Inchmartine.

An Order under section 12(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 to provide for the construction of new side roads and the improvement of certain existing roads to form new and improved connections in relation to the trunk road; the stopping up of various existing accesses and the provision of a new means of access.

#### INTERCHANGE) (PROHIBITION OF SPECIFIED TURNS)

#### ORDER 2000

The Scottish Ministers hereby give notice that on 21st July 2000 they made an Order under section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to provide for the prohibition of specified turns at various locations on that part of the A90 (M90) Trunk Road between Middlebank Smallholdings and North Mains. The Order comes into force on 4th August 2000.

The effect of the Order is as stated in *The Edinburgh Gazette*, *The Dundee Courier and Advertiser* and *The Perthshire Advertiser* dated 6th March 1998.
