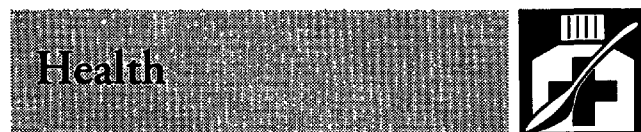

The Health Ministers, that is to say in respect of England, Scotland and Wales the Secretary of State concerned with health in England and in respect of Northern Ireland the Minister of Health, Social Services and Public Safety, acting jointly, hereby declare under section 65(7) of the Medicines Act 1968 that on and after 1 February 2001, the amendment to the Third Edition of the European Pharmacopoeia referred to in the Schedule hereto, is to have effect for the purposes of section 65 of the said Act.

**SCHEDULE***Amendment*

The General Chapter 5.2.8 - Minimising the Risk of Transmitting Animal Spongiform Encephalopathy Agents via Medicinal Products adopted by the European Pharmacopoeia Commission on 23rd November 2000 is to have effect in replacement for the General Chapter contained in the Third Edition of the European Pharmacopoeia, published under the direction of the Council of Europe (Partial Agreement) in accordance with the Convention on the Elaboration of a European Pharmacopoeia. The said revised General Chapter will be published in Pharmeuropa. Pharmeuropa is available on subscription from the Technical Secretariat of the European Pharmacopoeia Commission, B.P. 907, 67029 Strasbourg Cedex 1, France.
