Argyll and Bute Council

ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

Notice is hereby given that Argyll and Bute Council propose to make an Order under Section 68(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 stopping up the length of road described in the Schedule hereto.

The title of the Order is "The Argyll and Bute Council (Hope Street Helensburgh) (Stopping Up) Order 2001".

A copy of the proposed Order and of the accompanying plan showing the length of road to be stopped up, together with a statement of reasons for making the order have been deposited at:

Any person may, within 28 days from 29th March 2001, object to the making of the Order by notice in writing to the Head of Transportation Services, Manse Brae, Lochgilphead, Argyll, PA31 8RD. Objections should state the name and address of the objector,
