

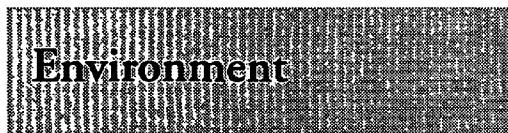

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with section 36(1)(a) of the Control of Pollution Act 1974, as amended, that application has been made to the Scottish Environment Protection Agency by Hydro Seafood GSP Ltd for consent to discharge the following:

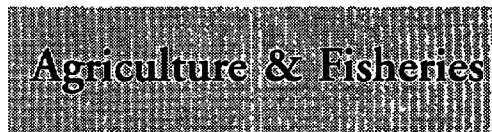
50 cubic metres per day of trade effluent to the Sound of Mull at National Grid Reference NM 6810 4450 from an existing Net Washing Station, Ardtornish, Morvern. The application refers to an existing process and involves extension of the outfall to a tidal water discharge point.

Any person who wishes to make representation regarding the above application should do so, in writing, to be received by the Scottish Environment Protection Agency, Carr's Corner, Lochybridge, Fort William, PH33 6TQ, not later than 29th May 2001, quoting Ref No WPC/N/62473(00). Animal Health

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, acting in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 1 and 8 of the Animal Health Act 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, makes the following order:

S.I. 2001/974

This order may be cited as the Foot-and-Mouth (Amendment) (England) (No. 3) Order 2001; it extends to England and came into force on the 14th March 2001 at 6 pm.

This Order, which extends to England, amends the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Order 1983 (S.I. 1983/1950, as amended) to allow movements through an area under the restrictions of a Form C Notice by railway, motorway or trunk road provided the animals are not unloaded in the area under restriction.
