Phase 3 - St Leonards Street, High Street, Wellgate, Wellgatehead, Ladyacre Road, St Vincent Place, Bannatyne Street, Kildare Road, Hall Place, Gallowhill Road, Hope Street, Hyndford Road over their entire lengths and Bloomgate, Lanark between its Junction with Hope Street and High Street.
