THE A8 TRUNK ROAD (EAST HAMILTON STREET,  
GREENOCK) (PROHIBITION OF SPECIFIED TURNS) ORDER

The Scottish Ministers hereby give notice that they propose to make the above Order under section 1(1) as read with sections 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit traffic on that length of the A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road at East Hamilton Street, Greenock, from its junction with Sinclair Street in a westerly direction to its junction with Cartsdyke Roundabout, a distance of 800 metres or thereby, from making any of the following turns:

1. Right turns from Sinclair Street onto the eastbound carriageway of the A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road at East Hamilton Street, Greenock;
2. U-turns from the westbound carriageway of the A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road onto the eastbound carriageway of the said

A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road adjacent to MacKenzie Street, MacDougall Street and Ratho Street;

3. U-turns from the eastbound carriageway of the A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road onto the westbound carriageway of the said A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road adjacent to MacKenzie Street, MacDougall Street and Ratho Street.

#### *Alternative Routes*

1. Traffic on Sinclair Street should turn left and proceed westbound on the A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road to Cartdyke Roundabout, circle the roundabout and continue eastbound on the A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road, a distance of 1.6 kilometres or thereby;
2. Westbound traffic wishing to perform a U turn should continue westbound on the A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road to Cartdyke Roundabout, circle the roundabout and proceed eastbound on the A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road, distances of 1.0 kilometres, 0.85 kilometres and 0.75 kilometres or thereby respectively;
3. Eastbound traffic wishing to perform a U turn should continue eastbound on the A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road to Newark Roundabout, circle the roundabout and proceed westbound on the A8 Edinburgh—Greenock Trunk Road, distances of 6.75 kilometres, 6.85 kilometres and 7.0 kilometres or thereby respectively.

The Order does not apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform and to vehicles being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes.
