The Scottish Ministers have given the above Directions to the Scottish Environment Protection Agency ("SEPA") in exercise of powers conferred by sections 40(1) and (2) and 122(2) of the Environment Act 1995 and section 2(6) of the Water Environment and Water Services (Scotland) Act 2003 and all other powers enabling them to do so.

The Scotland River Basin District (Standards) Amendment Directions 2015 amend the Scotland River Basin District (Standards) Directions 2014 so as to direct SEPA to apply some new and modified environmental quality standards in relation to the Scotland River Basin District.

The Cross-Border River Basin Districts (Scotland) Directions 2015 direct SEPA as to the exercise of its functions in relation to the Scottish part of the Solway Tweed River Basin District and, for some functions, the Scottish part of the Northumbria River Basin District. The previous Cross-Border River Basin Districts (Scotland) Directions 2014 are revoked.

The Solway Tweed River Basin District (Standards) (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Directions 2015 amend the Solway Tweed River Basin District (Standards) (Scotland) Directions 2014 so as to direct SEPA to apply some new and modified environmental quality standards in relation to the Solway Tweed River Basin District.

Among other things these Directions supplement the measures needed to comply with:

- Directive 2000/60/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing a framework for Community action in the field of water policy, as last amended by Commission Directive 2014/101/EU,
  - Directive 2008/105/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on environmental quality standards in the field of water policy, as amended by Directive 2013/39/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council, and
  - Directive 2006/118/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of groundwater against pollution and deterioration, as amended by Commission Directive 2014/80/EU.
- In particular, these Directions supplement the measures needed to comply with the amendments made to the above Directives by Directive 2013/39/EU in relation to environmental quality standards, Directive 2014/80/EU in relation to the protection of groundwater, and Directive 2014/101/EU in relation to standards for monitoring water quality.
