2. Adapt existing infrastructure, construct new setback walls and install floodgates to allow access for maintenance along Riverside Drive from Discovery Point to Bridge View Station Building
3. Construct new set back flood defence walls and install floodgates to allow access for maintenance between Bridge View Station Building to Dundee Airport.

The effects of the proposed operations will be to generally reduce the risk of flooding to residential, community and business properties along the City Quay from Camperdown Dock gate to Tay Road Bridge and along Riverside Drive from Discovery Point to Bridge View Station Building and to mitigate the effects of flooding to open space, residential, community and business properties from Bridge View Station Building to Dundee Airport.
