Notice is hereby given that Banks Renewables (Birneyknowe Wind Farm) Ltd of Inkerman House, St John's Road, Meadowfield, Durham, DH7 8XL (Company Registration Number 06903043) has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent to construct and operate a wind farm at land to the west of the A6088, approximately 4km south east of Hawick and 2km to the west of Bonchester Bridge that lies within the Scottish Borders local authority area (Central Grid Reference NT 54537 11301 and for a direction under Section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted. The installed capacity of the proposed generating station would be over 50 MW comprising 15 turbines with a ground to blade tip height of 132 metres.

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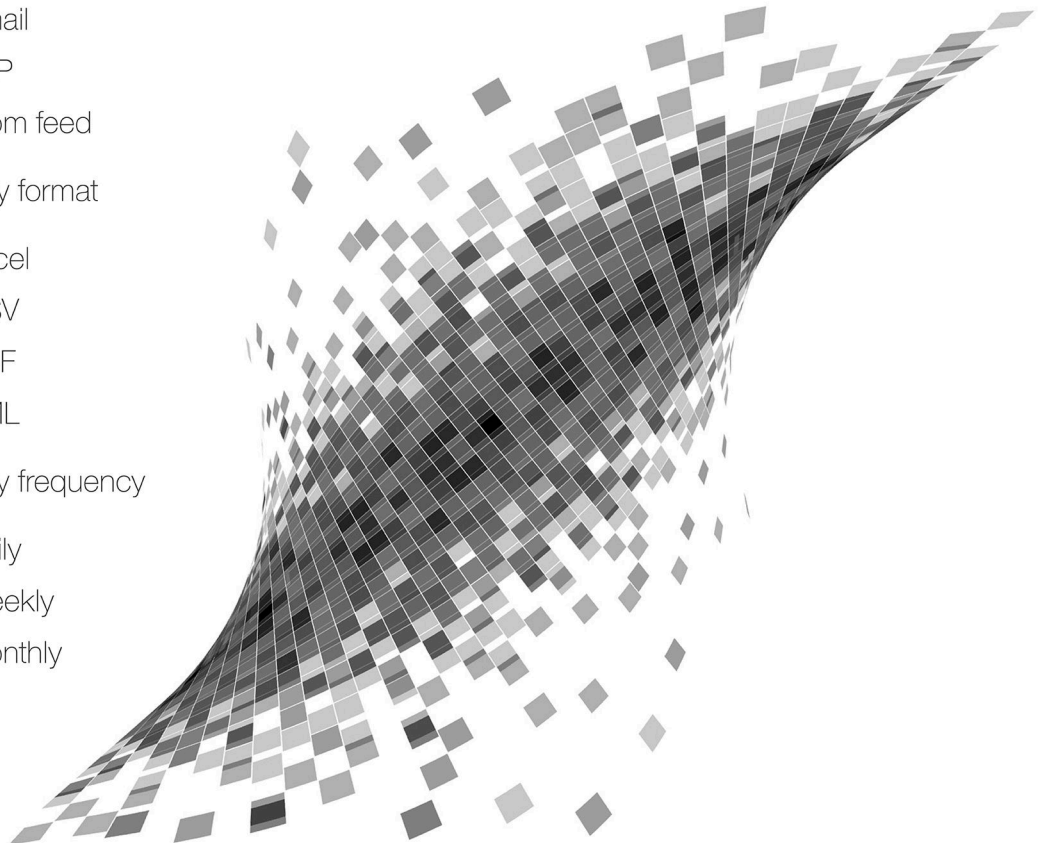
