BY THE QUEEN A PROCLAMATION APPOINTING TUESDAY 26TH DECEMBER 2017 AND MONDAY 28TH MAY 2018 AS BANK HOLIDAYS IN SCOTLAND ELIZABETH R.

Whereas We consider it desirable that Tuesday, the twenty-sixth day of December in the year 2017, and Monday, the twenty-eighth day of May in the year 2018 should be bank holidays in Scotland:

Now, therefore, We, in pursuance of section 1(3) of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971, do hereby appoint Tuesday, the twenty-sixth day of December in the year 2017 and Monday, the twenty-eighth day of May in the year 2018 to be bank holidays in Scotland.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace this fourteenth day of June in the year of our Lord two thousand and seventeen in the sixty-sixth year of Our Reign.

BY THE QUEEN A PROCLAMATION DETERMINING THE SPECIFICATIONS AND DESIGNS FOR A NEW SERIES OF ONE HUNDRED POUND AND TWENTY-FIVE POUND GOLD COINS; A NEW SERIES OF ONE HUNDRED POUND PLATINUM COINS; A NEW SERIES OF TEN POUND AND FIVE POUND SILVER COINS; AND A NEW SERIES OF FIVE POUND CUPRO-NICKEL COINS ELIZABETH R.

Whereas under section 3(1)(a), (b), (c), (cc), (cd), (d) and (dd) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to determine the denomination, the design and dimensions of coins to be made at Our Mint, to determine the weight and fineness of certain gold coins, the remedy to be allowed in the making of such coins and their least current weight, and to determine the weight and composition of coins other than gold coins or coins of silver of Our Maundy money, and the remedy to be allowed in the making of such coins, to provide for the manner of measurement of the variation from the standard weight of coins, and to determine the percentage of impurities which such coins may contain:

And Whereas under section 3(1)(f) and (ff) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to direct that coins made at Our Mint other than gold, silver, cupro-nickel and bronze coins shall be current and that any coin shall be legal tender for the payment of any amount:

And Whereas under section 6(2) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to prescribe the composition of the standard trial plates to be used for determining the justness of coins of any metal other than gold, silver or cupro-nickel:

And Whereas it appears to Us desirable to order that there should be made at Our Mint a new series of coins of the denominations of one hundred pounds and twenty-five pounds in gold, a new series of one hundred pound coins in platinum, a new series of coins of the denominations of ten pounds and five pounds in silver, and a new series of five pound coins in cupro-nickel:

We, therefore, in pursuance of the said section 3(1)(a), (b), (c), (cc), (cd), (d), (dd), (f) and (ff), the said section 6(2), and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, proclaim, direct and ordain as follows:

ONE HUNDRED POUND GOLD COIN

1. (1) A new coin of gold of the denomination of one hundred pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 31.21 grammes, a standard diameter of 32.69 millimetres, a millesimal fineness of not less than 999.9, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said gold coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight or diameter, specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.105 grammes; and

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(4) The least current weight of the said gold coin shall be 31.01 grammes.

(5) The design of the said gold coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "ELIZABETH II · D · G · REG · F · D · 100 POUNDS", and for the reverse a rearing unicorn accompanied by a shield depicting a lion rampant with the inscription "UNICORN OF SCOTLAND 10Z · FINE GOLD · 999.9 · 2018". The coin shall have a grained edge.'

TWENTY-FIVE POUND COIN

2. (1) A new coin of gold of the denomination of twenty-five pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 7.80 grammes, a standard diameter of 22 millimetres, a millesimal fineness of not less than 999.9, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said gold coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight or diameter specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.025 grammes; and

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(4) The least current weight of the said gold coin shall be 7.75 grammes.

(5) The design of the said gold coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "ELIZABETH II · D · G · REG · F · D · 25 POUNDS", and for the reverse a rearing unicorn accompanied by a shield depicting a lion rampant with the inscription "UNICORN OF SCOTLAND 1/40Z · FINE GOLD · 999.9 · 2018". The coin shall have a grained edge.'

ONE HUNDRED POUND PLATINUM COIN

3. (1) A new coin of platinum of the denomination of one hundred pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 31.21 grammes, a standard diameter of 32.69 millimetres and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said platinum coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight or diameter specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.15 grammes; and

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The said platinum coin may contain impurities of five-tenths of one per centum.

(4) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(5) The composition of the standard trial plates to be used for determining the justness of the said platinum coin shall be pure platinum.

(6) The design of the said platinum coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "ELIZABETH II · D · G · REG · F · D · 100 POUNDS", and for the reverse either:

(a) a griffin accompanied by a shield depicting the badge of the House of Windsor with the inscription "GRIFFIN OF EDWARD III · 10Z FINE PLATINUM · 999.5 · 2018"; or

(b) a rearing unicorn accompanied by a shield depicting a lion rampant with the inscription "UNICORN OF SCOTLAND 10Z · FINE PLATINUM · 999.5 · 2019".

The coins shall have a grained edge.'

(7) The said platinum coin shall be legal tender for payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

TEN POUND COIN

4. (1) A new coin of silver of the denomination of ten pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 311.527 grammes, a standard diameter of 89.15 millimetres, a standard composition of not less than 999.9 parts per thousand fine silver, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said silver coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight or diameter specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.48 grammes; and

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(4) The design of the said silver coin shall be as follows:
'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "· ELIZABETH II · D · G · REG · F · D · 10 POUNDS", and for the reverse either:

(a) a griffin accompanied by a shield depicting the badge of the House of Windsor with the inscription "GRIFFIN OF EDWARD III 10OZ · FINE SILVER · 999.9 · 2018"; or

(b) a rearing unicorn accompanied by a shield depicting a lion rampant with the inscription "UNICORN OF SCOTLAND 10OZ · FINE SILVER · 999.9 · 2019".

The coins shall have a grained edge.'

(5) The said silver coin shall be legal tender for payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

FIVE POUND SILVER COIN

5. (1) A new coin of silver of the denomination of five pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 62.42 grammes, a standard diameter of 38.61 millimetres, a standard composition of not less than 999.9 parts per thousand fine silver, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said silver coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight or diameter specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.195 grammes; and

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(4) The design of the said silver coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "· ELIZABETH II · D · G · REG · F · D · 5 POUNDS", and for the reverse a rearing unicorn accompanied by a shield depicting a lion rampant with the inscription "UNICORN OF SCOTLAND 2OZ · FINE SILVER · 999.9 · 2018". The coin shall have a grained edge.'

(5) The said silver coin shall be legal tender for payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

FIVE POUND CUPRO-NICKEL COIN

6. (1) A new coin of cupro-nickel of the denomination of five pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 28.28 grammes, a standard diameter of 38.61 millimetres, a standard composition of seventy-five per centum copper and twenty-five per centum nickel, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said cupro-nickel coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, composition or dimensions specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.75 grammes;

(b) a variation from the said standard composition of two per centum copper and two per centum nickel; and

(c) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(4) The said cupro-nickel coin may contain impurities of three-quarters of one per centum.

(5) The design of the said cupro-nickel coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "· ELIZABETH II · D · G · REG · FID · DEF · 5 POUNDS", and for the reverse either:

(a) a lion accompanied by a shield depicting Our Royal Arms with the inscription "· LION OF ENGLAND ·" and the date of the year; or

(b) a rearing unicorn accompanied by a shield depicting a lion rampant with the inscription "· UNICORN OF SCOTLAND ·" and the date of the year.

The coins shall have a grained edge.'

(6) The said cupro-nickel coin shall be legal tender for payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

7. This Proclamation shall come into force on the fifteenth day of June Two thousand and seventeen.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this fourteenth day of June in the year of Our Lord Two thousand and seventeen and in the sixty-sixth year of Our Reign.

BY THE QUEEN A PROCLAMATION DETERMINING THE SPECIFICATIONS AND DESIGNS FOR NEW FIVE POUND COINS IN GOLD AND IN SILVER COMMEMORATING THE HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST WORLD WAR ELIZABETH R.

Whereas under section 3(1)(a), (b), (cc), (cd) and (d) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to determine the denomination, the design and dimensions of coins to be made at Our Mint, to determine the weight and composition of coins other than gold coins or coins of silver of Our Maundy money, and the remedy to be allowed in the making of such coins, and to provide for the manner of measurement of the variation from the standard weight of coins:

And Whereas under section 3(1)(ff) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to direct that any coin shall be legal tender for the payment of any amount:

And Whereas it appears to Us desirable to order that, to commemorate the hundredth anniversary of the First World War, there should be made at Our Mint new coins of the denomination of five pounds in gold and in silver:

We, therefore, in pursuance of the said section 3(1)(a), (b), (cc), (cd), (d) and (ff), and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, proclaim, direct and ordain as follows:

GOLD COIN

1. (1) A new coin of gold of the denomination of five pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard diameter of 38.610 millimetres, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said gold coin a remedy (that is a variation from the standard diameter specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

SILVER COIN

2. (1) A new coin of silver of the denomination of five pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 28.28 grammes, a standard diameter of 38.61 millimetres, a standard composition of 925 parts per thousand fine silver, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said silver coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, composition or dimensions specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.45 grammes;

(b) a variation from the said standard composition of five parts per thousand fine silver; and

(c) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(4) The said silver coin shall be legal tender for the payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

DESIGN OF THE COINS

3. The design of the said coins shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "· ELIZABETH II · D · G · REG · F · D · 5 POUNDS · 2017", and for the reverse either:

(a) a portrait of Noel Chavasse VC, accompanied by an image of him tending to a wounded soldier with the inscription "1914 THE FIRST WORLD WAR 1918" and "NOEL CHAVASSE VC" around the coin; separated by poppy flowers attached with barbed wire. The said coin shall have a plain edge and in incuse letters the inscription "DUTY CALLED AND CALLED ME TO OBEY";

(b) a depiction of the Battle of Arras, showing howitzers with planes flying overhead and the inscription "· 1914 THE FIRST WORLD WAR 1918 · ARRAS". The said coin shall have a plain edge and in incuse letters the inscription "THE MONSTROUS ANGER OF THE GUNS";

(c) a view of a Sopwith Camel shown from directly in front of the propeller and the inscription "1914 THE FIRST WORLD WAR 1918". The said coin shall have a plain edge and in incuse letters the inscription "IRRITATUS LACESSIT CRABRO";

(d) an image of a First World War gas mask and the inscription "1914 THE FIRST WORLD WAR 1918". The said coin shall have a plain edge and in incuse letters the inscription "GUTTERING, CHOKING, DROWNING";

(e) a depiction of a First World War medical station with troops carrying a stretcher and the inscription “· 1914 THE FIRST WORLD WAR 1918 · MEDICAL SERVICES”. NOTICE OF THE ISSUE OF A SUBMARINE PIPELINE WORKS AUTHORISATION

The Oil and Gas Authority gives notice that it has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by ARCO British Limited, LLC whose address is Chertsey Road, Sunbury on Thames, Middlesex, TW16 7BP for the construction of a pipeline system between the Arundel Well, the Arundel Midline Tie-in Structure and the IUTA.

Except with the consent of the Oil and Gas Authority, the 273.1 Millimetre Production pipeline shall only be used to convey Produced Fluids; the 60.3 Millimetre Gas Lift pipeline shall only be used to convey Gas Lift; the 60.3 Millimetre Methanol pipeline shall only be used to convey Methanol; the Controls Jumper Bundle shall only be used to convey Hydraulic and Scale Inhibitor; the Controls Jumper Bundle shall only be used to convey Hydraulic and Methanol; the Electrical Flying Lead shall only be used to convey Signal and the 4 x Electrical Flying Leads shall only be used to convey Power/Signal.

The pipelines may be used by the Holder and with the Holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Oil and Gas Authority, by other persons.

ARCO British Limited, LLC have been appointed operator of the pipelines.

Notice is hereby given that NLEI Ltd, (company number SC511747 at registered address Clyde View (Suite F3), Riverside Business Park, 22 Pottery Street, Greenock, PA15 2UZ) has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate a wind farm known as North Lowther Energy Initiative (NLEI) within the Queensberry Estate, approximately 5km south of Crawfordjohn, 2km northeast of Sanquhar and west of Wanlockhead in Dumfries and Galloway (Central Grid Reference 283464, 615138). The installed capacity of the proposed generating station would be up to 147 MW comprising up to 35 turbines with a maximum ground to blade tip height of 149 metres. The proposed development is subject to Environmental Impact Assessment and the developer has produced an Environmental Statement.

NLEI Ltd has also applied for a direction under Section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.
