The proposed development is located approximately 2km north west of Elvanfoot, 2.5km and 5km north east of Leadhills village and Wanlockhead respectively and 5.5km south west of Crawfordjohn, in South Lanarkshire and is subject to Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) under the above regulations.

Notice is hereby given that Additional Information (“AI”) has been submitted to Scottish Ministers by Harryburn Wind Farm Ltd relating to an application made in May 2017 under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 and for a direction under s57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 to construct and operate a wind farm with a rated capacity of more than 50 MW comprising 17 horizontal axis wind turbines, each up to 149.9 m maximum to tip height with a total installed capacity of over 50 MW. Key elements of the Proposal include associated underground cabling, access tracks and turning points, crane hard standings, control building and substation compound (including an energy storage facility), watercourse crossings, battery storage units, and met and power performance masts (“the application”).

The application has been amended by a letter to the Energy Consents Unit dated 23 August 2018 to remove one turbine.

The AI provides environmental information to enable an assessment of the amended application which comprises 16 turbines. The other key elements of the proposal remain as described above. The application remains one for consent under section 36 Electricity Act 1989 and for a direction under s57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997.

The AI comprises 2 volumes as follows: Volume 1 – Main Text, including chapters relating to landscape and visual assessment, updated cumulative assessment, cultural heritage and a revised habitat management plan and Appendices; Volume 2 – supporting Visualisations

For the avoidance of doubt, these Terms and Conditions shall prevail over any other terms or conditions (whether or not inconsistent with these Terms and Conditions) contained or referred to in any correspondence or documentation submitted by the Advertiser or implied by custom, practice or course of dealing which the parties agree shall not apply, unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing by the Publisher.

3 The Publisher reserves the right, to be exercised at its sole and absolute discretion, to make reasonable efforts to verify the validity of the Advertiser.

4 The Publisher may, at its sole and absolute discretion, edit the Notice, subject to the following restrictions:

7 For the avoidance of doubt, subject to clause 6 above, in no circumstances shall the Publisher be liable for any economic losses (including, without limitation, loss of revenues, profits, contracts, business or anticipated savings), any loss of goodwill or reputation, or any special, indirect or consequential damages (however arising, including negligence).

8 Where the Publisher is responsible for any error including which, in the Publisher's reasonable opinion, causes a substantive change to the meaning of a Notice or would affect the legal efficacy of a Notice, upon becoming aware of such error, the Publisher shall publish the corrected Notice at no charge and at the next suitable opportunity. Both parties agree (including on behalf of any principal, if applicable) that this shall be the sole remedy of the Advertiser (including any principal, if applicable) and full extent of the limit of the Publishers liability in these circumstances.

10 The location of the Notice in The Gazette shall be at the discretion of the Publisher. For the avoidance of doubt, the Notice shall be published in the house style of The Gazette.

11 The Advertiser warrants:

11.1 that it has the right, power and authority to submit the Notice;

11.2 the Notice is not false, inaccurate, misleading, nor does it contain potentially fraudulent information;

11.3 the Notice is submitted in good faith, does not contravene any law (statutory or otherwise) nor is it in any way illegal, defamatory or an infringement of any other party's rights or an infringement of the

British Code of Advertising Practice (as amended and updated from time to time), nor is it subject to any court order prohibiting such publication.

12 To the extent permissible by law the Publisher excludes all warranties, conditions or other terms, whether implied by statute or otherwise, relating to the placing of any Notices.

13 The Advertiser agrees to fully indemnify and hold the Publisher and The National Archives (or any successor organisation), including any affiliates, officers, directors, agents, subcontractors and employees harmless from all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including, without limitation) any direct, indirect, consequential and/or special losses and/or damage, loss of profit, loss of reputation and/or goodwill and all interest, penalties and legal costs (calculated on a full indemnity basis) and all other professional costs and/or expenses (including legal costs) suffered or incurred (including negligence) in respect of any matter arising out of, in connection with or relating to any Notice, including (without limitation) in respect of any claim and/or demand (including threatened and/or potential claims or demands) made by any third party which may constitute a breach, threatened and/or potential breach by the Advertiser (or their principal) of these Terms and Conditions or any breach and/or potential breach by the Advertiser of any law and/or any of the rights of a third party. The Publisher shall consult with the Advertiser as to the way in which such applicable claims, demands or potential claims or demands are handled but the Publisher shall retain the sole, absolute and final decision on all aspects of any matter arising from the aforementioned indemnity, including the choice of instructing legal representatives, steps taken in or related litigation and/or decisions to settle the case. In the event of any conflict, the terms set out in this clause 18 shall prevail:

18.1 The Local Newspaper Notice may be placed in a local newspaper by any subcontractor and/or a third party organisation at the Publisher's sole and absolute discretion and the Advertiser hereby consents to such use (including any activity that is ancillary and/or reasonably necessary to such use). 19 In the event that a corrected Local Newspaper Notice is not published for whatever reason, the total aggregate liability of the Publisher and The National Archives, whether direct or indirect, and including (without limitation) all liabilities, losses, damages, expenses, costs (including all interest, penalties, legal costs and/or other professional costs and/or expenses) suffered or incurred, howsoever arising (including negligence), whether arising from the acts and/or omissions of the Publisher, The National Archives and/or the Advertiser and/or any third party (including, without limitation, any principal of the Advertiser) or arising out of or made in connection with the Notice or otherwise shall be limited to the value of the Local Newspaper Notice placed through The Gazette except that nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall limit or exclude any liability for fraudulent misrepresentation, or for death or personal injury resulting from the Publisher's or The National Archives' negligence or the negligence of their agents, subcontractors and/or employees or third parties acting on behalf of the Publisher.

20 The Advertiser accepts that the Charges may be amended from time to time and will be payable at the rate in force at the time of invoicing unless otherwise agreed by the Publisher in writing.
