The installed capacity of the proposed generating station would be in excess of 50 MW, comprising up to 14 turbines with a ground to blade tip height of up to 149.9 metres and associated infrastructure. The proposal is subject to Environmental Impact Assessment and the developer has produced an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report.

EDF Energy Renewables Limited has now submitted additional information to Scottish Ministers, which includes information relating to a change in the layout proposed for the scheme. To address concerns raised within consultation responses, the layout has been revised to relocate five of the proposed fourteen wind turbines, which also results in a reduction in the length of access track required. NOTICE OF CANCELLATION AND RE-DESIGNATION OF DYSART, LESLIE AND MARKINCH CONSERVATION AREAS

NOTICE is hereby given that in accordance with Section 61 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Act 1997 the Fife Council has cancelled the existing Dysart, Leslie and Markinch Conservation Areas and simultaneously re-designated them with altered boundaries.

The effect of the designation is that planning applications in all conservation areas, including the amended areas outlined above, will be required to conform to Fife Council Policy on development in conservation areas. All buildings within Conservation Areas, whether or not they are listed buildings, are protected by law and may not be demolished without consent from the Council. Certain alterations and other developments will also require consent. Trees are also protected by law and the written consent of the Council must be obtained before lopping, pruning, pollarding, felling or uprooting any tree. Any proposed development in, or adjacent to, a Conservation Area which could affect its character must be advertised. Only applications for full planning permission will be accepted for any development. In assessing development proposals, special consideration will be given to the preservation or enhancement of the character of the Conservation Area. Copies of these amended boundaries and guidance relating to development in conservation areas can be viewed online at <https://www.fife.gov.uk/conservationareas>. The new conservation area boundaries are as follows:

Dysart Conservation Area

Commencing at the junction of the Western pier of Dysart Harbour and the Mean Low Water Mark, thence, in a northerly direction along the boundary wall of Ravenscraig Park to its junction with West Quality Street and Dysart Road. Then in an easterly direction to the boundary wall of the Bowling Green and thence along the rear curtilage boundary of the properties abutting Norman Road to its junction with Windmill Road. Turning northwards along the curtilage boundary of Dysart Barony Parish Church and returning to run westwards along the rear boundaries of 1 – 9 Normand Road to its junction with Terrace Street. Continuing eastwards to include the rear boundary of 6 and 8 Terrace Street and 11-27 Normand Road to its junction with Station Road and thence around the Normand Road U.F. Church to return at the junction of Normand Road and Normand Brae. Thence, southwards along the centre of Normand Brae to the rear of 62 Normand Road. Thence, SW along the rear boundary of Nos.62-20 Normand Road, turning SE at No.18 to follow the rear boundaries of Nos.8-10 Ivy Lane to Hill Street, continuing down the centre of the road to the junction with Orchard Place, turning SE and continuing down the centre of the road to a point opposite the boundary between Nos.14 and 20 Meikle Square. Continuing across the end of the cul-de-sac and the boundary between 69 High Street and 17/19 Meikle Square, to the centre of the High Street. Thence, turning in an easterly direction along the southern edge of the cul-de-sac to the NE corner of the rear garden of 8 Victoria Street, turning SE to the junction with Howard Place. Leslie Conservation Area

Commencing at Leslie Bridge, on the A911, the boundary follows the left bank of the Camby Burn until the Community is reached. From there, the boundary separating The Community from the properties fronting onto the Green, Greenside, Greenside Place, and whilst the latter properties are incorporated, those at Monks Walk are not included. From the Town Hall the boundary turns westwards along the wall between the Community and the properties in the High Street and Barony Place. At No.89 High Street, the boundary turns to include the

properties fronting the High Street but not those fronting The Bowery, by following the boundary between them, until the road known as the Bowery of reached. The boundary follows the boundary of 1 North Street with The Bowery, crossing the road to the continue along the NE garden boundary of Levenside to its corner, turning NW following the rear boundaries of 2-46 North Street, thence at the NW corner of the Leslie Baptist Church Hall, following the E side of Murray place to the road junction intersection, crossing the road to follow the E boundary of Back Braes, Drumness and the Club to the NW corner of the car park. Thence, westwards across the play area to join the SE front boundary with Pepper Knowe, turning NW along the N edge of the path to the end of Back Row. Thence, south-westerly along the N edge of the road to Calvine, following the E and N boundary and those of Struan Cottage, Dunvegan, No.11, Hillview, Burnside Cottage to the junction with the E boundary of 30/32 Patterson Park, thence, southerly direction along the boundaries with 2/4 Back Row, crossing the road to follow the W edge of Croft Road to the junction with Mansfield, crossing the road to follow the southern edge of the road along the Common. Continuing along the end of the cul-de-sac to join the W end of South Street West, along the front boundaries of No.s 1-12a South Street West and the Transport of Delight, along the W side of Norman Place to the end. Thence, along the NE boundary of Fettykil Lodge, continuing in the same direction to the Fettykil Path including the SE boundary of Flear and Thompson, crossing Fettykil Path to continue along the NW edge of The Orchard to the rear boundary of 222 High Street and running in a general north-easterly direction until the grounds of Leslie House are met. From this junction, the boundary follows the westernmost edge of the Leslie House Garden, but incorporates the Duchess Lodge. It then runs eastwards along the main entrance to and on the wall on the northern boundary of the Leslie House Garden, as far as the Leslie Bridge and the point of commencement.

Markinch Conservation Area

Commencing at the NE corner of the garden of Mansfield, Kirk Wynd, the boundary follows the southern edge of the road NE to the junction with School Street, thence, crossing to the N edge and continuing in a westerly direction to 17-21 School Street. Thence, turning N to follow the E boundary of 17a School Street to its end, turning SW along the boundaries of The Hill, Stob Cross, The Teachers House, School Street, 11, 11a School Street and Hilltop View 15 Stob Street to Stob Cross Road. The boundary crosses the road to continue along the rear boundaries of No.s 1-23 Hill Terrace, thence, SE along the boundaries of 1 and 2 Croft Villas to the intersection with the SE boundary of 2/4 Croft Crescent to Croft Crescent. Thence, turning SE to follow the E edge of the road to its junction with Croft Road. At this point the boundary continues across the junction to the NW corner of 32 Commercial Street, turning S to continue along the W edge of Commercial Street to the N corner of the boundary of 22 Commercial Street, continuing in an easterly direction along the S boundary of 5 Glass Street to join and cross Glass Street to No. 20, turning N and then NE along the rear boundaries of 2 Kirk Wynd, Nos. 4 and 6 Henderson Place, the SE corner of The Old Manse boundary to the area of open ground known as The Glebe. Thence, along the boundaries of 8-20 Glass Street and the NE boundary of 7 Brunton Road to where it meets the N edge of Brunton Road. 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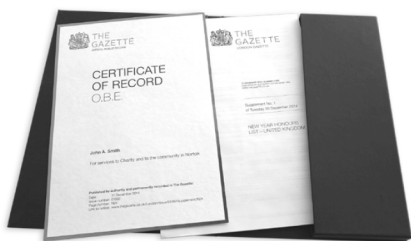

The folder contains a pocket, ideal to store additional papers or memorabilia. Examples of the awards you may wish to commemorate are the Victoria Cross, Military Cross, Mentioned in Despatches or citation for a gallantry award.



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By placing a Notice in The Gazette you are consenting to put official information permanently on the public record and in the public domain, online (in The Gazette website or via The Gazette mobile app), in print, and via a data service (rather than by having to search for notices on The Gazette website, customers can either create a pdf of the Notices that they are interested in, or subscribe to an electronic version of The Gazette (in full or in part) which is provided as a data service).

The Publisher reserves the right to modify these Terms and Conditions at any time. Such modifications shall be effective immediately upon publication. By submitting Notices to The Gazette after the Publisher has published such modifications, the Advertiser, including any principal, agrees to be bound by the revised Terms and Conditions.

1 Definitions

1.3 any reference to any legislative provision shall be deemed to include any subsequent re-enactment or amending provision.

2 By submitting a Notice to the Publisher, the Advertiser agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions which, unless stated otherwise in these Terms and Conditions, represent the entire terms agreed between the parties in relation to the publication of Notices in The Gazette and which every Notice shall be subject to. For the avoidance of doubt, these Terms and Conditions shall prevail over any other terms or conditions (whether or not inconsistent with these Terms and Conditions) contained or referred to in any correspondence or documentation submitted by the Advertiser or implied by custom, practice or course of dealing which the parties agree shall not apply, unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing by the Publisher.

12 To the extent permissible by law the Publisher excludes all warranties, conditions or other terms, whether implied by statute or otherwise, relating to the placing of any Notices.

13 The Advertiser agrees to fully indemnify (as a debt) and hold the Publisher and The National Archives or any successor organisation, including any affiliates, officers, directors, agents, subcontractors and employees harmless from all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including, without limitation) any direct, indirect, consequential and/or special losses and/or damage, loss of profit, loss of reputation and/or goodwill and all interest, penalties and legal costs (calculated on a full indemnity basis) and all other professional costs and/or expenses (including legal costs) suffered or incurred (including negligence) in respect of any matter arising out of, in connection with or relating to any Notice (including, without limitation, clause 11 of the Terms and Conditions) and including (without limitation) in respect of any claim and/or demand (including threatened and/or potential claims or demands) made by any third party which may constitute a breach and/or potential breach by the Advertiser (or their principal) of these Terms and Conditions or of any law and/or any of the rights of a third party. For the avoidance of doubt, all Notices and any content therein shall be Crown copyright and may be subject to the Open Government Licence (or any variation thereof).

16 The Advertiser accepts that the purpose of The Gazette is to disseminate information of interest to the public as widely as possible in the public interest. The Advertiser accepts that the information contained in the Notices published in The Gazette may be used for additional purposes by the Publisher or third parties after publication as stated above and that such use may be beyond the control of The Gazette. In such instances, the Advertiser agrees that the Publisher shall have no liability whatsoever in respect of such use by the Publisher or third parties.

17 The Advertiser acknowledges and agrees that the publication of any Notice is subject to any court order and/or direction of the court or such other regulatory and/or enforcement authorities including the Information Commissioner's Office, the police, the Financial Conduct Authority (and such other related regulatory organisations), the Solicitors Regulation Authority and such other authorities as may be applicable (without limitation) and that the Publisher may delay, refuse to publish or withdraw from publication if it has received evidence to that effect and may not publish such notice until it has received written evidence from the court (as the Publisher may reasonably require from time to time) that demonstrates that any previous order and/or direction has been withdrawn and/or is no longer applicable (as the Publisher may reasonably require from time to time) and/or, subject to any statutory and/or applicable laws, The Gazette may share information and/or data related to the Notice and/or the Advertiser's account related to such authorities and the Advertiser hereby consents to such disclosure(s).

In the event of any conflict, the terms set out in this clause 18 shall prevail:

23 These Terms and Conditions and all other express terms of the contract shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of England and the parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.

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
