ARLA FOODS LIMITED POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2012

In accordance with Paragraph 4 of Schedule 7 to the Pollution Prevention and Control (Scotland) Regulations, notice is hereby given that **Arla Foods Limited** has applied to the Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) to vary (change) their permit under Regulation 46 of the regulations. This is in respect of activities being carried out namely **the treatment and processing of milk** in an installation at **Lockerbie Creamery, Priestdykes, Lockerbie, DG11 1LW**.

The change in the operation proposed by the application is:

Upgrade and replacement of existing effluent treatment facility with anaerobic membrane bioreactor technology. The resulting biogas will be fully treated at the site to meet the required specification before being injected into the national gas grid network. Further changes at the site include the installation of Combined Heat and Power (CHP) plant. This variation application introduces new activities under the PPC regulations that will be undertaken wholly within the existing footprint of the installation.

THE TAXATION OF CHARGEABLE GAINS (GILT-EDGED SECURITIES) ORDER 2020

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 1 of Schedule 9 to the Taxation of Chargeable Gains Act 1992, made the Capital Gains Tax (Gilt-edged Securities) Order 2020 on 09 July 2020. The Order has been published as Statutory Instrument 2020 No. 715.
