The Oil and Gas Authority gives notice that it has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by Neptune E&P UK Limited whose address is Nova North, 11 Bressenden Place, London, England, SW1E 5BY for the construction and use of a pipeline system between the ETAP PDR Platform and the Seagull Manifold and between the Egret Manifold and the Seagull Manifold.

The pipelines may be used by the Holder and with the Holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Oil and Gas Authority, by other persons.
