SECTION 36 APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO CONSTRUCT 39 TURBINES ON LAND 8 KM WEST OF LAGGAN

Scottish Ministers have appointed Mr Keith Bray BSc(Hons) MRTPI to consider and submit and report to them on an application under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate the Glenshero Wind Farm on land 8 km west of Laggan, PH20 1AJ. The Reporter will hold a public inquiry to obtain more information on certain matters before he reports to Scottish Ministers on the case. The matters to be considered during virtual sessions are:

- Assessment of landscape, visual and cumulative impacts, including on the special landscape qualities of the Cairngorms National Park and any Special Landscape Areas. (Inquiry Session 1)
- Assessment of impacts on key attributes and qualities of affected Wild Land Areas. (Inquiry Session 2)
- Conditions and legal agreement. (Hearing Session 1)
- Planning/energy policy and economic benefits. (Hearing Session 2)

The sessions will begin at 10:00 on Tuesday 10 November 2020. Then from each day after the sessions will begin at 9:30 am. The public inquiry is estimated to run for 6 days and expected to conclude on Tuesday 16 November 2020.

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that project to form bunds to address landslide risk at the A83 Glen Kinglas is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

(a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely –

– the size and design of the whole project;
the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;
the production of waste;
pollution and nuisances;
the risks to human health (for example due to water contamination or air pollution);
areas classified or protected under national legislation;
Natura 2000 areas designated by Member States pursuant to Directive 92/43/EEC and Directive 2009/147/EC,

(b) the results of the Environmental Screening Assessment under section 55A(2) of the 1984 Act and site ecological surveys undertaken in August 2020 which determined that with mitigation measures in place, there will be no significant effects on the environment, and in particular, the Glen Etive and Glen Fyne Special Protection Area,

(c) the information set out in the Record of Determination dated 10 August 2020, available at <https://www.transport.gov.scot/media/48268/record-of-determination-a83-glen-kinglas-bund-formation.pdf>.
The project does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment.

The main reasons for the conclusion are:

(a) There will be a minor loss of some habitats which are ubiquitous in the wider area. Additionally, the areas that will be lost have been disturbed by grazing and are species-poor compared to typical examples of these habitats;

(b) The scheme does not lie within a densely populated area, sites of historical, archaeological or cultural significance or sites designated for their geology or soils;

(c) Consultation with Scottish Natural Heritage, Scottish Environment Protection Agency, Loch Lomond and the Trossachs National Park and Argyll Fisheries Trust has been undertaken. Mitigation measures were proposed and agreed and it is considered that following the implementation of the mitigation measures that significant environmental effects are not anticipated;

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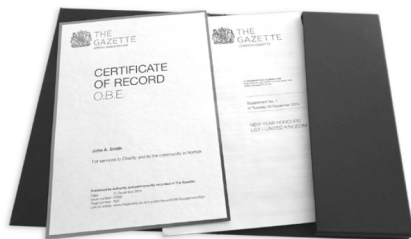
