Notice is hereby given that Cumberhead West Wind Farm Ltd, company registration number SC535501, with its Registered Office at 320 St Vincent Street, Glasgow, G2 5AD, has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent under Section 36 (S36) of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate a wind farm known as Cumberhead West Wind Farm, 4.3 km west of Coalburn in South Lanarkshire (Central Grid Reference NS 75107 34361). The installed capacity of the proposed generating station would be up to 126MW comprising up to 21 turbines with a maximum ground to blade tip height of 200 metres, plus around 40MW of energy storage output capacity. The proposed development has been subject to Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and an EIA Report has been produced to accompany the application for consent.

Cumberhead West Wind Farm Ltd, has also applied for a direction under Section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.
