### SCOTTISH HYDRO ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION PLC ELECTRICITY ACT 1989 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997 THE ELECTRICITY WORKS (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT) (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2017

Notice is hereby given that Scottish Hydro Electric Transmission Plc, "the Company", (registered in Scotland under company registration number SC213461 at Inveralmond House 200 Dunkeld Road, Perth, PH1 3AQ) has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent under section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989, to upgrade approximately 168 km of existing overhead line between Tower 559R at Kintore Substation and the Applicants boundary at Blairingone (East of Stirling) at the midpoint between Tower 33 and 34 to allow the OHL voltage to increase from 275kV to 400kV. The proposed development is subject to Environmental Impact Assessment and an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report has been produced to accompany the application for consent.

The Company has also requested a direction under section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project for re-surfacing the A77 from Burnside to Dowhill is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

- (a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely (i) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;
- (ii) the production of waste;
- (iii) pollution and nuisances;
- (iv) the risks to human health (for example due to water contamination or air pollution)
- (b) the results of the Environmental Screening Assessment under section 55A(2) of the 1984 Act,
- (c) the information set out in the Record of Determination dated 12 January 2021, available at <https://www.transport.gov.scot/transport-network/roads/road-orders-and-records-of-determination/#63527>, the project does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment.

The main reasons for the conclusion that no Environmental Impact Assessment is required are:

- (a) Construction activities are restricted to the existing carriageway;
- (b) The works will be limited to the like-for-like replacement of the carriageway pavement;
- (c) The works will not impact the Turnberry Dunes Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI), and the surrounding landscape does not provide suitable habitat for protected species;
- (d) No significant residual impacts are predicted. Disruption due to construction activities is not expected to be significant and will be mitigated as far as is reasonably practicable;
- (e) Traffic management and working times will be communicated to local residents in advance of the works.

The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:

- (a) Materials will be derived from recycled, secondary or re-used origin as far as practicable within the design specifications;
- (b) Pollution prevention measures and best practice will be adhered to at all times;
- (c) The waste hierarchy will be applied to all waste arising;
- (d) The design option (replacing the defective surfacing) conveys sustainability benefits by significantly reducing the quantity of maintenance interventions required at the location over approximately 20 years.

18.3 To the extent that such local newspaper and the applicable terms allow, where the Publisher, any subcontractor, any third party acting on behalf of the Publisher and/or the local newspaper is responsible for any error, the Publisher shall arrange for the local newspaper to publish the corrected Local Newspaper Notice at no additional cost to the Advertiser. Both parties agree (including on behalf of any principal, if applicable) that this shall be the sole remedy of the Advertiser (including any principal, if applicable) and the full extent of the limit of liability in these circumstances;

In the event that a corrected Local Newspaper Notice is not published for whatever reason, the total aggregate liability of the Publisher and The National Archives, whether direct or indirect, and including (without limitation) all liabilities, losses, damages, expenses, costs (including all interest, penalties, legal costs and/or other professional costs and/or expenses) suffered or incurred, howsoever arising (including negligence), whether arising from the acts and/or omissions of the Publisher, The National Archives and/or the Advertiser and/or any third party (including, without limitation, any principal of the Advertiser) or arising out of or made in connection with the Notice or otherwise shall be limited to the value of the Local Newspaper Notice placed through The Gazette except that nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall limit or exclude any liability for fraudulent misrepresentation, or for death or personal injury resulting from the Publisher's or The National Archives' negligence or the negligence of the their agents, subcontractors and/or employees or third parties acting on behalf of the Publisher.

After the 10 months period has lapsed any correspondence received will be returned to the sender where possible or securely destroyed, and the Advertiser or executor's name and address details will be removed from the Forwarding Service.
