FLOOD RISK MANAGEMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 2009 AND THE FLOOD RISK MANAGEMENT (FLOOD PROTECTION SCHEMES, POTENTIALLY VULNERABLE AREAS AND LOCAL PLAN DISTRICTS) (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2010 GLENMOSSTON FLOOD PROTECTION SCHEME 2021

In accordance with Section 60 and Schedule 2 of the Act and Parts II, III and IV of the Regulations, Inverclyde Council proposes the above Flood Protection Scheme. This constitutes a Notice under Paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 of the Act.

The effect of the proposed scheme will be to manage the risk of flooding within the village of Kilmacolm from Glenmosston Burn. The proposed operations to be carried out include the construction of an earth bund with a v-notch weir to control the flow of Glenmosston Burn. In addition, debris deflectors will be installed to prevent debris from building up at the v-notch weir. The proposed operations will be carried out at the location of Glenmosston Wildlife Reserve, Kilmacolm.

The benefits of the scheme will be to manage the risk of flooding within the village of Kilmacolm from Glenmosston Burn. The proposed operations are designed to protect Kilmacolm Village from flooding from the Glenmosston Burn up to a 1 in 200 year event (0.5% annual exceedance probability). The Scheme is unlikely to have a significant effect on the environment and in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Regulations, a screening opinion has been sought from SEPA, Scottish Natural Heritage and Scottish Water to confirm that an environmental impact assessment is not necessary. The scheme documents can be inspected at <https://www.inverclyde.gov.uk/environment/roads-lighting/flood-prevention> until the date a decision is made under paragraph 4(1), 7(4) or, as the case may be, 9(1) of Schedule 2 of the Act. Any person may make an objection to the proposed scheme to Inverclyde Council by **30th March 2021**.

Any such objection must be in writing, note the name and address of the objector, and be accompanied by a statement of the reasons for the objection. Objections should be sent to the Head of Legal and Property Services, Inverclyde Council, Municipal Buildings, Greenock PA15 1LY. Where an objector has an interest in any land on which the proposed operations are to be carried out or which may be affected by any of the proposed operations, or by any alteration in the flow of water caused by any of the operations, that person's objection must include:-

- Details of the land in which the objector has an interest;
- Disclosure of the nature of the objector's interest in the land; and
- Details of which aspects of the scheme operations affect the objector.

If no valid objections are made to the scheme, then the Council must make the final decision to confirm or reject the proposed scheme. Where valid objections are made to the scheme, the Council will consider the objections and make a preliminary decision to either a) confirm the proposed scheme without modification; b) confirm the proposed scheme with modifications; or c) reject the proposed scheme. Where an objection is received from a relevant objector, who is a person to whom paragraph 5(6) of Schedule 2 of the Act applies, the Council must notify the Scottish Ministers of the preliminary decision. The Scottish Ministers must then decide whether to consider the scheme or not. If the Scottish Ministers decide to consider the scheme and valid objections remain, then the Scottish Ministers must cause a Public Local Inquiry to be held. After considering the outcome of the Public Local Inquiry, the Scottish Ministers must make the final decision to: a) confirm the proposed scheme without modification, b) confirm the proposed scheme with modification, or c) reject the proposed scheme. Where the Scottish Ministers decide not to consider the scheme, the Council must hold a hearing to consider the proposed scheme. Following the outcome of the hearing, the Council must make the final decision to a) confirm the proposed scheme without modification, b) confirm the proposed scheme with modification, or c) reject the proposed scheme.

Notification of the final decision, whether made by the Council or the Scottish Ministers, will be given to every person given notice.

2 By submitting a Notice to the Publisher, the Advertiser agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions which, unless stated otherwise in these Terms and Conditions, represent the entire terms agreed between the parties in relation to the publication of Notices in The Gazette and which every Notice shall be subject to. 13 The Advertiser agrees to fully indemnify (as a debt) and hold the Publisher and The National Archives or any successor organisation, including any affiliates, officers, directors, agents, subcontractors and employees harmless from all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including, without limitation) any direct, indirect, consequential and/or special losses and/or damage, loss of profit, loss of reputation and/or goodwill and all interest, penalties and legal costs (calculated on a full indemnity basis) and all other professional costs and/or expenses (including legal costs) suffered or incurred (including negligence) in respect of any matter arising out of, in connection with or relating to any Notice (including, without limitation, clause 11 of the Terms and Conditions) and including (without limitation) in respect of any claim and/or demand (including threatened and/or potential claims or demands) made by any third party which may constitute a breach and/or potential breach by the Advertiser (or their principal) of these Terms and Conditions or of any law and/or any of the rights of a third party.
