Notice is hereby given that Kennoxhead Wind Farm Limited, a limited liability company incorporated under the laws of England with registered number 12602263, and having its registered office at Level 25, 1 Canada Square, London, EH14 5AA, and a place of business at 26 Frederick St, Edinburgh, EH2 2JR has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate a wind farm known as Kennoxhead Wind Farm Extension II (Penbreck), south-west of Glespin, South Lanarkshire (Central Grid Reference 274066 622665). The installed capacity of the proposed generating station extension would be around 45.6 MW comprising up to eight turbines with a maximum ground to blade tip height of 220 metres. The proposed development is a second extension to the consented Kennoxhead Wind Farm comprising up to 19 turbines with a maximum blade tip height of 180 metres and has been subject to Environmental Impact Assessment. An EIA Report has been produced to accompany the application for consent.

Kennoxhead Wind Farm Limited has also applied for a direction under Section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.

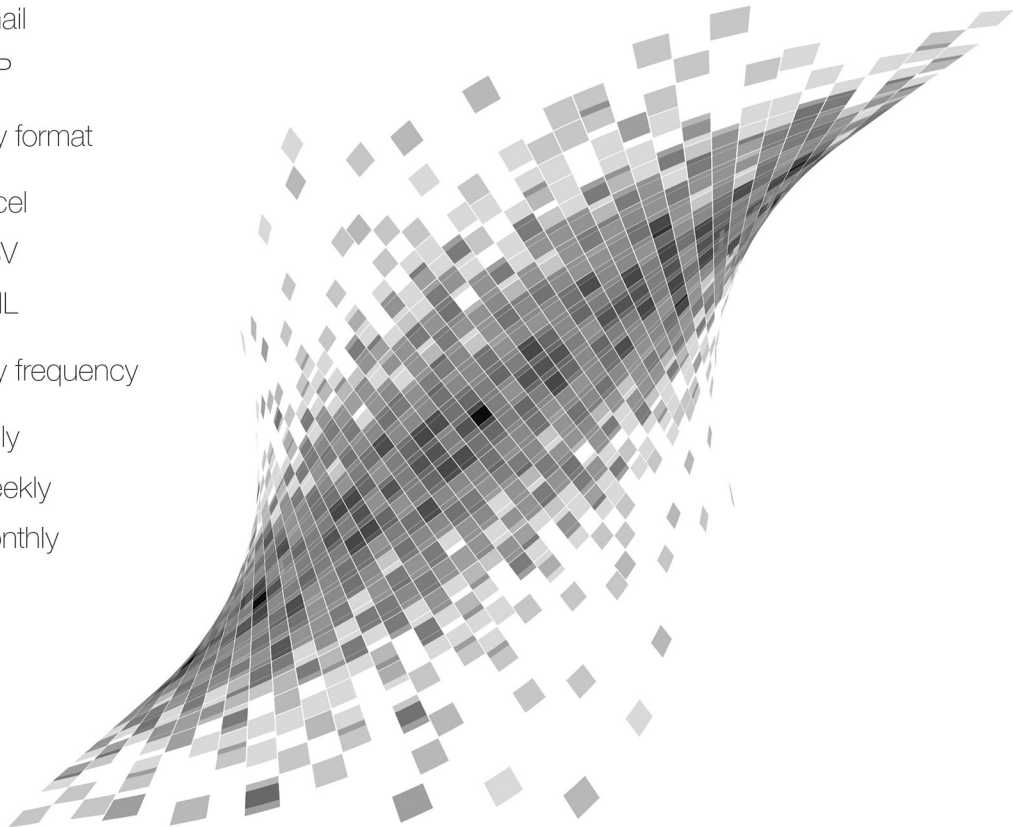

3 The Publisher reserves the right, to be exercised at its sole and absolute discretion, to make reasonable efforts to verify the validity of the Advertiser.

4 The Publisher may, at its sole and absolute discretion edit the Notice, subject to the following restrictions:

13 The Advertiser agrees to fully indemnify (as a debt) and hold the Publisher and The National Archives or any successor organisation, including any affiliates, officers, directors, agents, subcontractors and employees harmless from all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including, without limitation) any direct, indirect, consequential and/or special losses and/or damage, loss of profit, loss of reputation and/or goodwill and all interest, penalties and legal costs (calculated on a full indemnity basis) and all other professional costs and/or expenses (including legal costs) suffered or incurred (including negligence) in respect of any matter arising out of, in connection with or relating to any Notice (including, without limitation, clause 11 of the Terms and Conditions) and including (without limitation) in respect of any claim and/or demand (including threatened and/or potential claims or demands) made by any third party which may constitute a breach and/or potential breach by the Advertiser (or their principal) of these Terms and Conditions or of any law and/or any of the rights of a third party.
