Notice is hereby given that ScottishPower Renewables (UK) Ltd, (company registration number NI028425, having their registered office at The Soloist, 1 Lanyon Place, Belfast, Northern Ireland, BT1 3LP) has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate a Solar photovoltaic and Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) electricity generation station at Whitelee Windfarm, East Ayrshire (Central Grid Reference NS 517 455, E251749 N645527). The installed capacity of the generating station would be up to 90 megawatts. The proposed development is subject to Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) under the Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2017.

ScottishPower Renewables (UK) Ltd has also applied for a direction under section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project to undertake scour repair at Barlae Bridge on the A75 is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

(a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely –

(i) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;

(ii) the production of waste;

(iii) pollution and nuisances;

(iv) the risks to human health (for example due to water contamination or air pollution); and

(v) areas classified or protected under national legislation; Natura 2000 areas designated by Member States pursuant to Directive 92/43/EEC and Directive 2009/147/EC,

(b) the results of the Environmental Screening Assessment under section 55A(2) of the 1984 Act, the field survey undertaken on 4 May 2021 and the Assessment under regulation 48 of the Conservation (Natural Habitats, &c.) Regulations 1994 ("the 1994 Regulations") concluded that there would be no likely significant effects on the River Bladnoch Special Area of Conservation,

(c) the information set out in the Record of Determination dated 5 May 2021, available at <https://www.transport.gov.scot/transport-network/roads/road-orders-and-records-of-determination/#63527> the project does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment.

The main reasons for the conclusion that no Environmental Impact Assessment is required are:

(a) The 1994 Regulations Assessment has shown that there is enough information and assessment evidence to conclude that the proposed scheme will not likely cause a significant effect on the connected environmentally sensitive site, either alone or in combination with other projects or plans;

(b) The successful completion of the works will see an area of river bank scour addressed. As a result, a regular source of sediment will be removed from the watercourse; and

(c) With mitigation measures adhered to on site, it has been assessed that the works hold a negligible risk of causing a pollution event or resulting in a significant nuisance.

The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:

(a) The works will be undertaken out with fish spawning season and within a dry working area;

(b) The existing concrete plinth will be retained as far as practicable thereby reducing the volume of materials required and the volume of waste generated;

(c) Measures will be in place to ensure appropriate removal and disposal of waste, with the waste hierarchy being applied at all times; and

(d) The conditions of the licence obtained under the Water Environment (Controlled Activities) (Scotland) Regulations 2011 will be adhered to at all times.
