Notice is hereby given that Glendye Wind Farm Ltd (company registration number 09171944), with its Registered Office at 22-24 King Street, Maidenhead, Berkshire, SL6 1EF has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate a wind farm known as Glendye Wind Farm approximately 2km north-west of Fettercairn and 12km south of Strachan (Central Grid Reference 360000, 780000) within the local authority area of Aberdeenshire Council. The installed capacity of the proposed generating station would be over 50MW comprising up to 26 turbines with a maximum ground to blade tip height of 149.9 metres. An EIA Report has been produced to accompany the application for consent and in August 2020 Additional Information ("AI 2020") was submitted.

Glendye Wind Farm Ltd has also applied for a direction under Section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.

Glendye Wind Farm Ltd has now submitted a second package of Additional Information ("AI 2021") to the Scottish Ministers, which includes information relating to ornithology and peatland habitats.
