A9 EVELIX CUTHILL LINKS BRIDGE

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT

DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 55A OF THE ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project for replacing the parapet on the A9 Evelix Cuthill Links Bridge is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

- (a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely
 - (i) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;
 - (ii) the production of waste;
 - (iii) pollution and nuisances;
 - (iv) the risks to human health (for example due to water contamination or air pollution);
 - (v) areas classified or protected under national legislation; Natura 2000 areas designated by Member States pursuant to Directive 92/43/EEC and Directive 2009/147/EC,
- (b) the results of the Environmental Screening Assessment under section 55A(2) of the 1984 Act and the Assessment under the Conservation (Natural Habitats, &c.) Regulations 1994 which determined that there would be no likely significant effects on the River Evelix Special Area of Conservation, Dornoch Firth and Morrich More Special Area of Conservation, Dornoch Firth and Loch Fleet Special Protection Area, Moray Firth Special Area of Conservation and Dornoch Firth Site of Special Scientific Interest,
- (c) the information set out in the Record of Determination dated 8 July 2021, available at <https://www.transport.gov.scot/transport-network/roads/road-orders-and-records-of-determination/#63527>, the project does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment.

The main reasons for the conclusion that no Environmental Impact Assessment is required are:

- (a) The works will be temporary, localised, and short-term (less than 2 months in duration) and will be completed during daylight hours;
- (b) The works will not damage or alter the footprint of A9 Evelix Cuthill Links Bridge;
- (c) The works do not include any excavations or in-stream works;
- (d) Although the scheme has connectivity to several environmentally sensitive sites, works will not result in adverse effects on site integrity for nearby designated sites; and
- (e) The scheme is not located within a densely populated area.

The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:

- (a) Containment of the working area will be in place to prevent debris or pollutants from entering the surrounding environment;
- (b) Mitigation measures and best practice detailed in the Site Environmental Management Plan will ensure no significant negative impacts on sensitive receptors; and
- (c) Measures will be in place to ensure appropriate removal and disposal of waste.

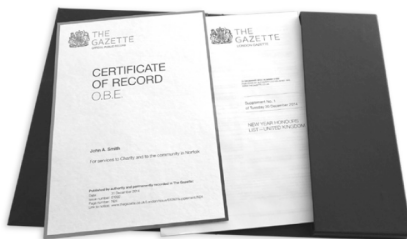

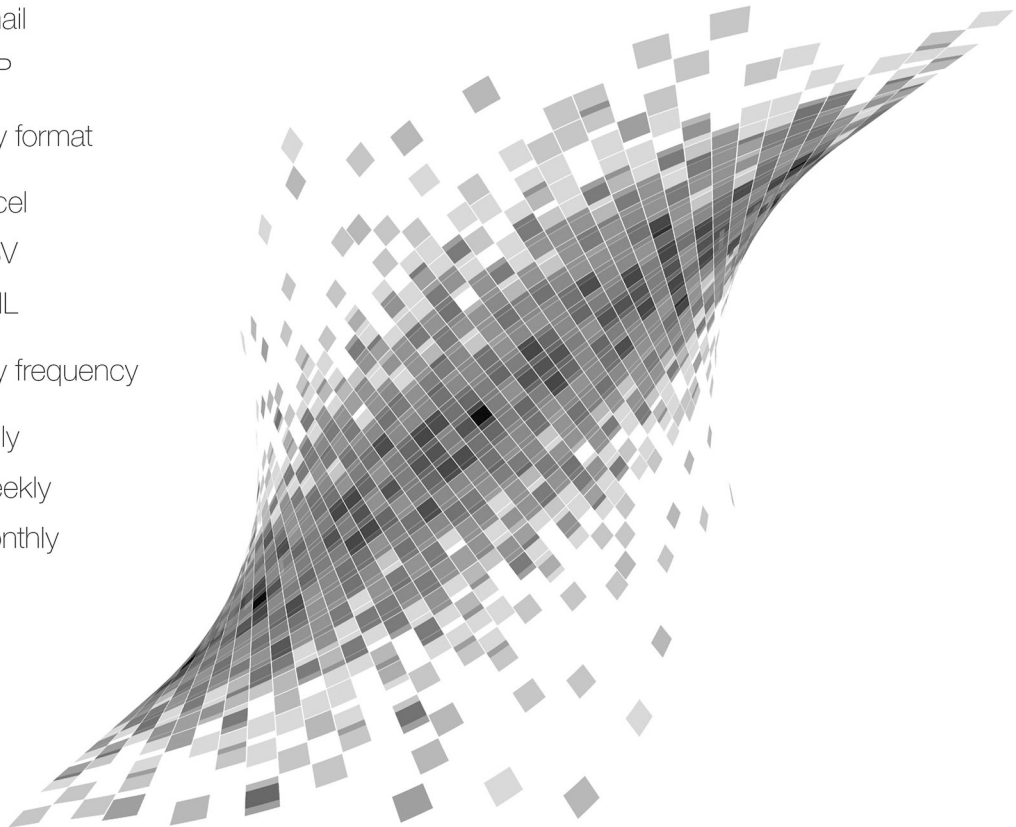
