TRANSPORT SCOTLAND NOTICE OF DETERMINATION A82 ARDLUI STATION ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 55A OF THE ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project for resurfacing works on the A82 at Ardlui is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

- (a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely
- (i) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;
 - (ii) the production of waste;
 - (iii) pollution and nuisances;
 - (iv) the risks to human health (for example due to water contamination or air pollution),

(b) the results of the Environmental Screening Assessment under section 55A(2) of the 1984 Act,

(c) the information set out in the Record of Determination dated 11 August 2021, available at <https://www.transport.gov.scot/transport-network/roads/road-orders-and-records-of-determination/#63527>, the project does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment.

The main reasons for the conclusion that no Environmental Impact Assessment is required are:

(a) The works are temporary, localised and short-term and will be completed over five nights;

(b) The works comprise like-for-like replacement of the road surfacing material;

(c) The works lie within the Loch Lomond National Scenic Area and the Loch Lomond and the Trossachs National Park however the works will not result in any adverse visual impacts;

(d) The works lie alongside a woodland recorded on the Ancient Woodland Inventory however there will be no tree felling associated with the works and therefore there will be no impacts on the woodland; and

(e) The scheme is situated in rural location with few residential properties.

The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:

(a) Pollution controls will be in place to contain debris and wastes produced during works;

(b) Resurfacing works will be restricted to made ground within the A82 carriageway boundary; and

(c) Mitigation measures detailed in the Site Environmental Management Plan will ensure no significant negative impacts on sensitive environmental receptors.
