Notice is hereby given that ScottishPower Renewables (UK) Limited, company registration number NI028425, with its Registered Office at The Soloist, 1 Lanyon Place, Belfast, Northern Ireland, BT1 3LP, has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate a windfarm known as Carrick Windfarm, located within the Carrick Forest, approximately 6km south of Straiton in South Ayrshire (British National Grid reference 237186, 598381).

ScottishPower Renewables (UK) Limited is applying to install and operate up to 13 wind turbines, with a blade tip height of up to 200m, and associated infrastructure (the Proposed Development) and would have a total generating capacity for the Site of around 86MW. The Proposed Development would also include up to 20MW of energy storage equipment. The Proposed Development is subject to Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) has been produced to accompany the application for consent.

ScottishPower Renewables (UK) Limited has also applied for a direction under Section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.

- Consent the proposal, with or without conditions attached; or
- Reject the proposal.

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project for resurfacing works from Dowhill to Chapleton Burn on the A77 is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

- (a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely
 - (i) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;
 - (ii) the production of waste;
 - (iii) pollution and nuisances;
 - (iv) the risks to human health (for example due to water contamination or air pollution),
- (b) the results of the Environmental Screening Assessment under section 55A(2) of the 1984 Act,

(c) the information set out in the Record of Determination dated 2 September 2021, available at <https://www.transport.gov.scot/transport-network/roads/road-orders-and-records-of-determination/#63527>, the project does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment.

The main reasons for the conclusion that no Environmental Impact Assessment is required are:

- (a) The works comprise like-for-like replacement of the road surfacing material;
- (b) The scheme is not situated in whole or in part in a “sensitive area” as listed under regulation 2 (1) of the Environmental Impact Assessment (Scotland) Regulations 1999 (as amended); and
- (c) Any potential impacts of the works are expected to be temporary, short-term, and limited to the construction phase.

The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:

- (a) Mitigation measures and best practice will be implemented to ensure no short-term or long-term significant negative impacts on the environment;
- (b) Materials will be derived from recycled, secondary or re-used origin as far as practicable within the design specifications; and
- (c) Measures will be in place to ensure appropriate removal and disposal of waste.
