The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project for resurfacing works on the A701 between Locharbriggs and Amisfield, to the north of Dumfries, is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

- (b) The scheme is not situated in whole or in part in a “sensitive area” as listed under regulation 2 (1) of the Environmental Impact Assessment (Scotland) Regulations 1999 (as amended); and
- (c) Any potential impacts of the works are expected to be temporary, short-term, and limited to the construction phase.

The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:

- (a) Mitigation measures and best practice will be implemented to ensure no short-term or long-term significant negative impacts on the environment;
- (b) Materials will be derived from recycled, secondary or re-used origin as far as practicable within the design specifications; and
- (c) Measures will be in place to ensure appropriate removal and disposal of waste.
