It will have a generating capacity exceeding 50MW and will comprise of up to **13 turbines** with associated infrastructure. The proposed Development is subject to Environmental Impact Assessment ("EIA"). An EIA report has been produced to accompany the application for consent.

Energiekontor UK Ltd has also applied for a direction under Section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the proposed Development be deemed to be granted.

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project for resurfacing works on the M8 at Junction 15 east bound is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to -

- (a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely
 - (i) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;

 - (iv) the risks to human health (for example due to water contamination or air pollution);
 - (v) landscapes and sites of historical, cultural or archaeological significance,

- (c) the information set out in the Record of Determination dated 20 September 2023, available at <https://www.transport.gov.scot/transport-network/roads/road-orders-and-records-of-determination/#63527>, the project does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment.

The main reasons for the conclusion that no Environmental Impact Assessment is required are:

- (a) The works are not situated in whole or in part in a "sensitive area" as listed under regulation 2 (1) of the Environmental Impact Assessment (Scotland) Regulations 1999 (as amended);
 - (b) The works will be restricted to already engineered ground and will not impact the Historic Environment Records;
 - (c) The works will be confined within the existing carriageway boundary and as a result will not require any land take or alter any local land uses; and
 - (d) Any potential impacts of the works are expected to be temporary, short-term, non-significant, and limited to the construction phase.
- The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:
- (a) Mitigation measures and best practice will be implemented to ensure no short-term or long-term significant negative impacts on the environment;
 - (b) Containment measures of the working area will be in place to prevent debris or pollutants from entering the surrounding environment; and
 - (c) Measures will be in place to ensure appropriate removal and disposal of waste.
