to construct and operate a floating offshore windfarm (and associated transmission assets) at the decommissioned Etrick and Blackbird oil and gas field, approximately 80 km east of Peterhead with a total area of 116 km² (central latitude and longitude co-ordinates: 1°36'3" W, 57°33'6" N (WGS84)). The installed capacity of the proposed generating station would be approximately 560 MW comprising 35 wind turbine generators with a maximum height of 264 m above Lowest Astronomical Tide. This proposed development is subject to environmental impact assessment ("EIA") under the above Regulations.

In such instances, the Notice Placer agrees that the Publisher shall have no liability whatsoever in respect of such use by the Publisher or third parties.
