The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project for refurbishment of existing lighting on the A82 within Ballifeary is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

- (a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely
 - (i) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;
