ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT

DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 55A OF THE ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project for the installation of eighty one new bollards on the A830 at Glenfinnan, is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

(a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely (i) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;

(ii) the production of waste;

(iii) pollution and nuisances;

(iv) the risks to human health (for example due to water contamination or air pollution);

(v) nature reserves and parks;

(vi) areas classified or protected under national legislation; Natura 2000 areas designated by Member States pursuant to Directive 92/43/EEC and Directive 2009/147/EC,

(b) the results of the Environmental Screening Assessment under section 55A(2) of the 1984 Act and the Assessment under regulation 48 of the Conservation (Natural Habitats, &c.) Regulations 1994 ("the 1994 Regulations") concluded that there would be no likely significant effects on the Loch Shiel Special Protection Area and the Ardgour Pinewoods Special Area of Conservation,

(c) the information set out in the Record of Determination dated 8 February 2024, available at <https://www.transport.gov.scot/transport-network/roads/road-orders-and-records-of-determination/#63527>, the project does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment.

The main reasons for the conclusion that no Environmental Impact Assessment is required are:

(a) Construction activities are restricted to the carriageway boundary;

(b) The works will not impact the special qualities for which the Loch Shiel National Scenic Area, the Loch Shiel Site of Special Scientific Interest and the Fassfern to Loch Ailort Road Cuttings Geological Conservation Review Site are designated;

(c) Although the works have connectivity to the Loch Shiel Special Protection Area and the Ardgour Pinewoods Special Area of Conservation, the assessment under the 1994 Regulations concluded that the works would not result in any likely significant effects on the qualifying features of these sites; and

(d) Any potential impacts of the works are expected to be temporary, short-term, and limited to the construction phase.

The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:

(a) Containment measures will be in place to prevent debris or pollutants from entering the surrounding environment;

(b) The works will be undertaken during daylight hours to minimise disturbance; and

(c) Measures will be in place to ensure appropriate removal and disposal of waste.
