The following Letter Patent was signed by His Majesty The King on 12 June 2024 in respect of the Post Office (Horizon System) Offences (Scotland) Bill ASP 6.

CHARLES THE THIRD by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Our other Realms and Territories King Head of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith To Our trusty and well beloved the members of the Scottish Parliament GREETING:

FORASMUCH as a Bill has been passed by the Scottish Parliament and has been submitted to Us for Our Royal Assent by the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament in accordance with the Scotland Act 1998 the short Title of which Bill is set forth in the Schedule hereto but that Bill by virtue of the Scotland Act 1998 does not become an Act of the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

Notice is hereby given that **TEVIOT WF LIMITED**, a company incorporated under the Companies Act with company number **SC653266** and having its registered office at **Muirhall Farm Auchengray, Carnwath, South Lanarkshire, Scotland, ML11 8LL** has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate a wind farm known as Teviot Wind Farm located off the A7, approximately 8km to the southwest of Hawick in the Scottish Borders (Central Grid Reference **NGT 344366 602906**). The application also requests that a direction be made by the Scottish Ministers under section 57 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997. The installed capacity of the proposed **Teviot Wind Farm** would be in excess of **50MW, comprising 62 turbines with a ground-to-blade tip height of up to 240 metres**. Eight turbines would have tip heights of up to 180m, five turbines would have tip heights of up to 200m, 38 turbines would have tip heights of up to 220m and 11 turbines will have tip heights of up to 240m. The Proposed Development has an indicative output capacity of 409MW and included a solar array and two battery storage facilities along with associated ancillary development. The proposal is subject to an Environmental Impact Assessment.

TEVIOT WIND FARM LIMITED has now submitted additional information to Scottish Ministers, which includes updated information where necessary to reflect the removal of nine turbines, and the repositioning of a further two turbines, as well as removal of the solar array. The newly proposed **Teviot Wind Farm** has an indicative capacity of **350MW, comprising 53 turbines with a ground-to-blade tip height of up to 240 metres, plus 100MW of battery storage**. Eight turbines will have tip heights of up to 180m, five turbines will have tip heights of up to 200m, 31 turbines will have tip heights of up to 220m and nine turbines will have tip heights of up to 240m.

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project to carry out resurfacing works on the M8 between Arkleston Cemetery and Junction 27, Renfrewshire is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) as the works fall within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

 - (b) The works will be confined within the existing carriageway boundaries and as a result will not require any land take and will not alter any local land uses; and
 - (c) Any potential impacts of the works are expected to be temporary, short-term, non-significant, and limited to the construction phase.
- The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:
- (a) Mitigation measures and best practice will be implemented to ensure no short-term or long-term significant negative impacts on the environment;
 - (b) Containment measures of the working area will be in place to prevent debris or pollutants from entering the surrounding environment; and
 - (c) Measures will be in place to ensure appropriate removal and disposal of waste.
