NOTICE OF DETERMINATION A92 NORTH OF KIRKCALDY ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 55A OF THE ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project for undertaking resurfacing works on the A92 to the north of Kirkcaldy is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as the works exceed 1 hectare in area and falls within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

- (a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely
 - (i) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;

The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:

- (a) Mitigation measures and best practice will be implemented to ensure no short-term or long-term significant negative impacts on the environment;
- (b) Containment measures of the working area will be in place to prevent debris or pollutants from entering the surrounding environment; and
- (c) Measures will be in place to ensure appropriate removal and disposal of waste.
