Notice is hereby given that Scottish Hydro Electric Transmission PLC, ("the Company") with company registration number SC213461, having its registered office at Inveralmond House, 200 Dunkeld Road, Perth, PH1 3QA has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent under section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989 to install a 132 kV overhead electric line between Strathy North 'T' (near Dallangwell) to a new cable sealing end (CSE) compound, prior to connecting into Connagill 275/132 kV substation (NC 282837, 960415 and NC 903120, 595414) near to Strathy. The total length of the line will be a maximum of approximately 13.5 km. Tower heights would vary depending on topography but would be approximately 31 m for an L7c tower and 48.5 m for an L8c tower. The proposed development has been subject to Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). An EIA Report has been produced to accompany the application for consent. The Company has also requested a direction under section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.

13 The Notice Placer agrees to fully indemnify (as a debt) and hold the Publisher and The National Archives or any successor organisation, including any affiliates, officers, directors, agents, subcontractors and employees harmless from all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including, without limitation) any direct, indirect, consequential and/or special losses and/or damage, loss of profit, loss of reputation and/or goodwill and all interest, penalties and legal costs (calculated on a full indemnity basis) and all other professional costs and/or expenses (including legal costs) suffered or incurred (including negligence) in respect of any matter
