Notice is hereby given that Lagrae Battery Storage Limited (**Company Reg. No. SC762496, Registered Office at Buccleuch Weatherhouse, Bowhill, Selkirk, Scotland, TD7 5ES**) has applied to the Scottish Ministers for consent under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate a **Battery Energy Storage System facility and associated development at land off Lagrae Road, north west of Kirkconnel Village in Dumfries & Galloway** (Central Grid Reference **E 271300, N 614500**). **The installed capacity of the proposed generating station would be approximately 400MW capacity, with ancillary development.**

Lagrae Battery Storage Limited has also applied for a direction under section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have determined that the project to undertake resurfacing works on the A86 at Meall Doire, east of Roybridge is a relevant project within the meaning of section 55A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as the works fall within Annex II of Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of certain public and private projects on the environment, but that having regard to –

- (a) the selection criteria contained in Annex III of that Directive, namely
- (i) the use of natural resources, in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity;
 - (ii) the production of waste;
 - (iii) pollution and nuisances;
 - (iv) the risks to human health (for example due to water contamination or air pollution),

(b) the results of the Environmental Screening Assessment under section 55A(2) of the 1984 Act,

(c) the information set out in the Record of Determination dated 22 July 2025, available at <https://www.transport.gov.scot/transport-network/roads/road-orders-and-records-of-determination/#63527>, the project does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment.

The main reasons for the conclusion that no Environmental Impact Assessment is required are:

- (a) The works will not impact the Parallel Roads of Lochaber Site of Special Scientific Interest;
- (b) The works are restricted to the carriageway boundary; and
- (c) Any potential impacts of the works are expected to be temporary, short-term, non-significant, and limited to the construction phase.

The features of the project which are envisaged to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment are:

- (a) Mitigation measures and best practice will be implemented to ensure no short-term or long-term significant negative impacts on the environment;
- (b) Containment measures of the working area will be in place to prevent debris or pollutants from entering the surrounding environment; and
- (c) Measures will be in place to ensure appropriate removal and disposal of waste;

17 The Notice Placer acknowledges and agrees that the publication of any Notice is subject to any court order and/or direction of the court or such other regulatory and/or enforcement authorities including the Information Commissioner's Office, the police, the Financial Conduct Authority (and such other related regulatory organisations), the Solicitors Regulation Authority and such other authorities as may be applicable (without limitation) and that the Publisher may delay, refuse to publish or withdraw from publication if it has received evidence to that effect and may not publish such notice until it has received written evidence from the court (as the

Publisher may reasonably require from time to time) that demonstrates that any previous order and/or direction has been withdrawn and/or is no longer applicable (as the Publisher may reasonably require from time to time) and/or, subject to any statutory and/or applicable laws, The Gazette may share information and/or data related to the Notice and/or the Notice Placer's account related to such authorities and the Notice Placer hereby consents to such disclosure(s).

18 In respect of any Local Newspaper Notice, this clause 18 shall apply. The Forwarding Service will remain in place for a period of 10 months from publication of the Notice in The Gazette, or 10 months from publication of the Notice in a Local Newspaper, in line with the Inheritance (Provision for Family and Dependants) Act 1975. After the 10 months period has lapsed any correspondence received will be posted to the sender where possible and or securely destroyed, and the Notice Placer or executor's name and address details will be removed from the Forwarding Service.

20 The Notice Placer accepts that the Charges may be amended from time to time and will be payable at the rate in force at the time of invoicing unless otherwise agreed by the Publisher in writing. The Charges must be paid in full by the Notice Placer in advance of publication unless other requirements of the Publisher in respect of the payment of such Charges (as determined from time to time) are notified to the Notice Placer.
