CHARLES THE THIRD by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Our other Realms and Territories King Head of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith To Our trusty and well beloved the members of the Scottish Parliament GREETING:

FORASMUCH as a Bill has been passed by the Scottish Parliament and has been submitted to Us for Our Royal Assent by the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament in accordance with the Scotland Act 1998 the short Title of which Bill is set forth in the Schedule hereto but that Bill by virtue of the Scotland Act 1998 does not become an Act of the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

- to construct and operate an offshore wind farm in the North Sea off the east coast of Scotland, approximately 84km east of Peterhead with a total area of 333 km² (central latitude and longitude co-ordinates: 57°45'24 N 0°11'23 W (WGS84)). The installed capacity of the proposed generating station would be approximately 1,000 MW comprising of up to 72 wind turbine generators each with a **maximum hub height of 170 metres above Lowest Astronomical Tide** and maximum blade tip height of 310m above Lowest Astronomical Tide. This proposed development is subject to environmental impact assessment ("EIA") under the above Regulations.
