### ADVERT FOR PUBLICISING THE LAUNCH OF A SCOTTISH GOVERNMENT CONSULTATION AND STRATEGIC ENVIRONMENTAL REPORT

The Scottish Government have published the consultation on the West Coast of Scotland Nephrops and North Sea Nephrops Fisheries Management Plans (FMPs).

The two Nephrops FMPs have been prepared by the following UK fisheries authorities - Scottish Government, Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs and the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs in Northern Ireland - in collaboration with the Sea Fish Industry Authority (Seafish), as well as with input from a wide range of stakeholders and Statutory Nature Conservation Bodies.

The FMPs gather evidence of what we know about the state of the UK Nephrops fisheries, the management approach, and they set out policies and actions to restore or maintain the stocks at sustainable levels.

A Strategic Environmental Report (SEA) for Nephrops Fisheries Management Plans has also been completed for the two Nephrops FMPs to assesses the likely significant environmental effects of these plans and is part of this Consultation.
