## PROCLAMATIONS

### BY THE KING A PROCLAMATION DETERMINING THE SPECIFICATIONS AND DESIGN FOR A NEW TEN POUND SILVER PIEDFORT COIN CHARLES R.

Whereas under section 3(1)(a), (b), (c) (cd) and (d) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to determine the denomination, the design and dimensions of coins to be made at Our Mint, to determine the weight and fineness of certain gold and silver coins, and the remedy to be allowed in the making of such coins and for gold coins their least current weight, and to provide for the manner of measurement of the variation from the standard weight of coins:

And Whereas under section 3(1)(ff) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to direct that any coin shall be legal tender for the payment of any amount:

And Whereas it appears to Us desirable to order that there should be made at Our Mint a series of coins of the denomination of ten pounds in silver piedfort:

We, therefore, in pursuance of the said section 3(1)(a), (b), (c) (cd), (d) and (ff), and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, proclaim, direct and ordain as follows:

#### TEN POUND SILVER PIEDFORT COIN

1. (1) A new coin of silver piedfort of the denomination of ten pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 312.59 grammes, a standard diameter of 65 millimetres, a standard composition of not less than 999 parts per thousand fine silver, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said silver piedfort coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight or diameter specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 1.8 grammes; and

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(4) The design of the said silver piedfort coin shall be as follows: 'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "CHARLES III · D · G · REX · F · D · 10 POUNDS ·" and the date of the year, and for the reverse a depiction of a prism refracting a beam of light into a colour spectrum accompanied by the inscription "PINK FLOYD THE DARK SIDE OF THE MOON". The coin shall have a grained edge.'

(5) The said silver piedfort coin shall be legal tender for the payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

2. This Proclamation shall come into force on the second day of April Two thousand and twenty-six.

### BY THE KING A PROCLAMATION DETERMINING THE SPECIFICATIONS AND DESIGN FOR A NEW SERIES OF TWENTY-FIVE POUND, TEN POUND AND FIVE POUND COINS IN GOLD; A NEW SERIES OF FIVE POUND COINS IN SILVER; A NEW SERIES OF FIVE POUND COINS IN SILVER PIEDFORT; AND A NEW SERIES OF FIVE POUND COINS IN CUPRO-NICKEL CHARLES R.

Whereas under section 3(1)(a), (b), (c), (cc), (cd), (d) and (dd) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to determine the denomination, the design and dimensions of coins to be made at Our Mint, to determine the weight and fineness of certain gold and silver coins, the remedy to be allowed in the making of such coins and for gold coins their least current weight, and to determine the weight and composition of coins

other than gold coins or coins of silver of Our Maundy money, and the remedy to be allowed in the making of such coins, to provide for the manner of measurement of the variation from the standard weight of coins, and to determine the percentage of impurities which such coins may contain:

And Whereas under section 3(1)(ff) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to direct that any coin shall be legal tender for the payment of any amount:

And Whereas it appears to Us desirable to order that there should be made at Our Mint a new series of coins of the denomination of twenty-five pounds, ten pounds and five pounds in gold, five pounds in standard silver, five pounds in silver piedfort and five pounds in cupro-nickel:

We, therefore, in pursuance of the said section 3(1)(a), (b), (c), (cc), (cd), (d), (dd) and (ff), and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, proclaim, direct and ordain as follows:

#### TWENTY-FIVE POUND GOLD COIN

1. (1) A new coin of gold of the denomination of twenty-five pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 7.8 grammes, a standard diameter of 22 millimetres, a millesimal fineness of not less than 999.9, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said gold coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight or diameter specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.024 grammes; and

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The least current weight of the said gold coin shall be 7.77 grammes.

(4) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(5) The design of the said gold coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "CHARLES III · D · G · REX · F · D · 25 POUNDS ·" and the date of the year encircled by a decorative rose and beading, and for the reverse a depiction of a crowned Tudor rose surrounded by a rose vine, Our Royal cypher and the cypher of Her Majesty Queen Camilla, and accompanied by the inscriptions "ANNIVERSARY OF THE GOLD CROWN." and the dates "1526 - 2026". The coin shall have a grained edge.'

#### TEN POUND GOLD COIN

2. (1) A new coin of gold of the denomination of ten pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 3.13 grammes, a standard diameter of 16.5 millimetres, a millesimal fineness of not less than 999.9, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said gold coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight or diameter specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.018 grammes; and

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin.

(3) The least current weight of the said gold coin shall be 3.11 grammes.

(4) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(5) The design of the said gold coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "CHARLES III · D · G · REX · F · D · 10 POUNDS ·" and the date of the year encircled by a decorative rose and beading, and for the reverse a depiction of a crowned Tudor rose surrounded by a rose vine, Our Royal cypher and the cypher of Her Majesty Queen Camilla, and accompanied by the inscriptions "ANNIVERSARY OF THE GOLD CROWN." and the dates "1526 - 2026". The coin shall have a grained edge.'

#### FIVE POUND GOLD COIN

3. (1) A new coin of gold of the denomination of five pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 39.94 grammes, a standard diameter of 38.61 millimetres, a millesimal fineness of 916.7, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said gold coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, diameter, or fineness specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.072 grammes; and

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin; and  
 (c) a variation from the said standard millesimal fineness of two per mille.

(3) The least current weight of the said gold coin shall be 39.85 grammes.

(4) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(5) The design of the said gold coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "CHARLES III · D · G · REX · F · D · 5 POUNDS ·" and the date of the year encircled by a decorative rose and beading, and for the reverse a depiction of a crowned Tudor rose surrounded by a rose vine, Our Royal cypher and the cypher of Her Majesty Queen Camilla, and accompanied by the inscriptions "ANNIVERSARY OF THE GOLD CROWN." and the dates "1526 - 2026". The coin shall have a grained edge.'

#### **FIVE POUND STANDARD SILVER COIN**

4. (1) A new coin of silver of the denomination of five pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 28.28 grammes, a standard diameter of 38.61 millimetres, a standard composition of 925 parts per thousand fine silver, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said silver coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, diameter or composition specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.504 grammes;

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin; and

(c) a variation from the said standard composition of five parts per thousand fine silver.

(3) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(4) The design of the said five pound fine silver coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "CHARLES III · D · G · REX · F · D · 5 POUNDS ·" and the date of the year encircled by a decorative rose and beading, and for the reverse a depiction of a crowned Tudor rose surrounded by a rose vine, Our Royal cypher and the cypher of Her Majesty Queen Camilla, and accompanied by the inscriptions "ANNIVERSARY OF THE GOLD CROWN." and the dates "1526 - 2026". The coin shall have a grained edge.'

(5) The said silver coin shall be legal tender for the payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

#### **FIVE POUND SILVER PIEDFORT COIN**

5. (1) A new coin of silver piedfort of the denomination of five pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 56.56 grammes, a standard diameter of 38.61 millimetres, a standard composition of 925 parts per thousand fine silver, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said silver piedfort coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, diameter or composition specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.612 grammes;

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin; and

(c) a variation from the said standard composition of five parts per thousand fine silver.

(3) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(4) The design of the said five pound silver piedfort coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "CHARLES III · D · G · REX · F · D · 5 POUNDS ·" and the date of the year encircled by a decorative rose and beading, and for the reverse a depiction of a crowned Tudor rose surrounded by a rose vine, Our Royal cypher and the cypher of Her Majesty Queen Camilla, and accompanied by the inscriptions "ANNIVERSARY OF THE GOLD CROWN." and the dates "1526 - 2026". The coin shall have a grained edge.'

(5) The said silver coin shall be legal tender for the payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

#### **FIVE POUND CUPRO-NICKEL COIN**

6. (1) A new coin of cupro-nickel of the denomination of five pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 28.28 grammes, a standard diameter of 38.61 millimetres, a standard composition of seventy-five per centum copper and twenty-five per centum nickel, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said cupro-nickel coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, diameter or composition specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin of 0.852 grammes;

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.125 millimetres per coin; and

(c) a variation from the said standard composition of two per centum copper and two per centum nickel.

(3) The said cupro-nickel coin may contain impurities of three-quarters of one per centum.

(4) The variation from the standard weight will be measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogram of the coin.

(5) The design of the said five pound cupro-nickel coin shall be as follows:

'For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "CHARLES III · D · G · REX · F · D · 5 POUNDS ·" and the date of the year encircled by a decorative rose and beading, and for the reverse a depiction of a crowned Tudor rose surrounded by a rose vine, Our Royal cypher and the cypher of Her Majesty Queen Camilla, and accompanied by the inscriptions "ANNIVERSARY OF THE GOLD CROWN." and the dates "1526 - 2026". The coin shall have a grained edge.'

(6) The said cupro-nickel coin shall be legal tender for the payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

7. This Proclamation shall come into force on the second day of April Two thousand and twenty-six.

Notice is hereby given that Naturalis Energy Developments Limited (“the Company”), with company registration number 12222848, having its registered office at Third Floor, 10 Lower Grosvenor Place, London, England, SW1W 0EN has made an application (the “variation application”) to the Scottish Ministers to vary the consent granted under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 (the “section 36 consent”) to construct and operate Knockkippen Wind Farm on land North East of Patna (Central Grid Reference NS 440106) previously consented on the 30th of April 2025 by the Scottish Ministers. The installed capacity of the varied generating station would remain in excess of 50 MW comprising 12 wind turbines, 4 with a maximum tip height not exceeding 150 metres and 8 with a maximum tip height not exceeding 180 metres, Battery Energy Storage System and solar panel arrays, with no change in the scope of development from the section 36 consent.

The Company has also requested a direction under section 57(2ZA) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development deemed to be granted under the section 36 consent to be varied as specified in the direction.

The proposed variation is not subject to Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). A screening opinion was adopted by the Scottish Ministers on the 26th November 2025 confirming that the proposed variation is not subject to Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA).

The variation application seeks to make the following variation:

- Relocation of the substation (also referred to as a switching station) and BESS compounds approximately 1.5 km south-east, adjacent to the consented construction compound, within the 100 m micro-siting allowance for the Consented Development.
