7th Regiment of Foot—Assistant-Surgeon John O'Reilly, from half-pay 1st foot, to be Assistant-Surgeon, vice James, appointed to the Staff; dated September 12, 1824.

13th—Ensign James Jones to be Lieutenant, without purchase, vice Rothe, deceased. Richard William Croker, gent. to be Ensign, vice Jones. Both dated November 18, 1823.

21st—Captain Richard Doherty to be Major, by purchase, vice Maclaine, promoted. Lieutenant Marcus Beresford to be Captain, by purchase, vice Doherty. Second Lieutenant John Picton Beete to be First Lieutenant, by purchase, vice Beresford. William Henry Armstrong, gent. to be Second Lieutenant, by purchase, vice Beete. All dated September 16, 1824.

30th—John Charles Batley, gent. to be Ensign, without purchase, vice Vandersee, deceased; dated December 19, 1822.

35th—Lieutenant Fowl Moore, from the 87th foot, to be Lieutenant, vice Walsh, appointed to the 1st Royal Veteran Battalion.

38th—Lieutenant Charles John Boyes, from the 2d West India Regiment, to be Lieutenant, vice James Watson Boyes, who retires upon half-pay 21st foot. Both dated September 23, 1824.

48th—Assistant-Surgeon Richard Noble Starr, from half-pay of the regiment, to be Assistant-Surgeon.

57th—Brevet-Major John Ovens, from half-pay 74th foot, to be Captain, vice Westera Warner Lewis, who exchanges. Both dated September 16.

60th—Second Lieutenant Robert Price, from half-pay 2d Ceylon Regiment, to be Second Lieutenant, vice Carl Wewel Von Kruger, who exchanges, receiving the difference.

62d—Ensign George Damerum to be Lieutenant, by purchase, vice Michell, who retires. Both dated September 23.

63d—Brevet-Major Charles William Kerr, from the 3d Royal Veteran Battalion, to be Captain, vice Smith, who exchanges.

65th—Cornet Richard Dundas, from the 6th dragoons, to be Ensign, vice Addison, who exchanges. Both dated September 16, 1824.

69th—To be Lieutenants, without purchase—Ensign John Penn, vice Smith, promoted; dated May 11, 1823. Ensign James Eyre Muttelbury, vice Roy, deceased; dated January 28, 1824.

To be Ensign—William Semple, jun. gent. vice Muttelbury.

75th—Major Henry Viscount Barnard to be Lieutenant-Colonel, by purchase, vice Sir John Campbell, who retires. Captain William M'Adam to be Major, by purchase, vice Lord Barnard. Lieutenant Honourable J. C. Westera, from the 3d foot guards to be Captain, by purchase, vice M'Adam.

87th—Lieutenant Crosbie Morgell Christian, from the 1st Royal Veteran Battalion, to be Lieutenant, vice Moore, appointed to the 35th foot.

91st—Brevet-Lieutenant-Colonel John Macdonald to be Lieutenant-Colonel, by purchase, vice MacNeill, who retires. Captain Robert Anderson to be Major, by purchase, vice

Macdonald. Lieutenant William Fraser to be Captain, by purchase, vice Anderson. Ensign George Adam Barnes to be Lieutenant, by purchase, vice Fraser. William Marden Wetenhall, gent. to be Ensign, by purchase, vice Barnes.

2d West India Regiment—Lieutenant John Campbell, from the Ceylon Regiment, to be Lieutenant, vice Boyes, appointed to the 38th foot.

Ceylon Regiment—Lieutenant Thomas Eardley Hodges, from half-pay 21st foot, to be Lieutenant, vice Campbell, appointed to the 2d West India Regiment. All dated September 23.

Royal African Colonial Corps—Hospital Assistant John Bell (2d) to be Assistant-Surgeon, vice Geddes, whose appointment has not taken place. Dated July 8.

1st Royal Veteran Battalion—Lieutenant Thomas Walsh, from the 35th foot, to be Lieutenant, vice Christian, appointed to 87th foot. Dated September 23.

2d Royal Veteran Battalion—Captain William Smith, from the 63d foot, to be Captain, vice Kerr, who exchanges. Dated September 16. Assistant-Surgeon William Dillon, from half-pay 72d foot, to be Assistant-Surgeon, vice William Gardiner, who exchanges. Dated August 25.

STAFF.

Lieutenant Henry Anderson, from the 69th foot, to be Adjutant of a Recruiting District, vice Valentine Munbee, who retires upon half-pay 69th foot. Both dated September 23.

HOSPITAL STAFF.

Staff-Surgeon William Lyons, from half-pay, to be Surgeon to the Forces, vice Tully, promoted. Dated September 25. Assistant-Surgeon Isaac James, from the 7th foot, to be Assistant-Surgeon to the Forces, vice Muir, who retires upon half-pay 1st foot. Dated September 12.

MEMORANDA.

The Christian names of Ensign Lister, of the 50th foot, are Arthur O'Neill, and not St. George Lumley, as heretofore stated.

The name of the Ensign, appointed to the 47th foot, in July 1820, is *Morphy*, and not *Murphy*, as heretofore stated.

The Christian names of Captain Muller, of the 60th foot, are Augustus Frederick, and not Henry, as heretofore stated.

The commission of Ensign Hewson, of the 47th foot, as Ensign in the Army, has been antedated to 1st October 1819, that being the date it ought to bear, but he has not been allowed any back-pay.

The date of Major John Macdonald's (91st foot), promotion to be Lieutenant-Colonel, by Brevet, is 4th September 1817, and not 4th September 1824, as stated in the Gazette of the 18th ultimo.
