At the Court at *St. James's*, the 20th day of May 1835,

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

THIS day the Right Honourable Francis Nathaniel Marquess Conyngham and the Right Honourable George William Frederick Howard (commonly called Viscount Morpeth) were, by His Majesty's command, sworn of His Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, and took their respective places at the Board accordingly.

WHITEHALL, May 22, 1835.

The King has been pleased to direct letters patent to be passed under the Great Seal, constituting and appointing the Earl of Lichfield to be His Majesty's Postmaster-General.

May 20, 1835.

The King has been pleased to appoint Graham Spiers, Esq. to be Sheriff Depute of the shires of Elgin and Nairn, in the room of John Cuninghame, Esq. resigned.
