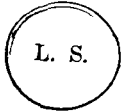

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Parish of BETHNAL GREEN, and to all Others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by the Act 11th and 12th Victoria, cap. 123, intituled "An Act to renew and amend an Act of the tenth year of Her present Majesty, for the more speedy removal of certain nuisances, and the prevention of contagious and epidemic diseases," and by virtue of an Order of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, bearing date the 27th day of March 1849, directing that the provisions of the said Act be continued in force throughout the whole of Great Britain; We, the General Board of Health, are authorized to issue such Directions and Regulations as the said Board shall think fit, for the prevention, as far as possible, or mitigation of epidemic, endemic, and contagious diseases;

And whereas the Parish of Bethnal Green appears to be affected by formidable epidemic and endemic disease, and it is desirable that further measures should be adopted for the prevention, if possible, or mitigation of such disease,

We, the General Board of Health, do now, in further exercise of the power vested in us as aforesaid, issue the Directions and Regulations hereinafter contained, to extend to the Parish of Bethnal Green.

1. That a sufficient and adequate staff of men, with all proper materials, be kept in readiness to carry out all works of lime washing, &c. in the cases of houses where Cholera has occurred, and in such other instances as the Medical Officers of the Parish shall direct.

2. That provision be forthwith made to secure additional supplies of water, to enable a complete and frequent washing of the Courts and other confined and close localities throughout the Parish.
