WHITEHALL, July 16, 1858.

The Queen has been pleased to direct letters-patent to be passed under the Great Seal, granting the dignity of a Baronet of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, unto Alexander Hutchinson Lawrence, Esq., of the Bengal Civil Service (eldest son of the late Sir Henry Montgomery Lawrence, K.C.B.), and to the heirs-male of his body lawfully begotten, with remainder, in default of such issue, to Henry Waldemar Lawrence, Esq. (brother of the said Alexander Hutchinson Lawrence), and the heirs-male of his body lawfully begotten.
