## SCOTTISH UNIVERSITIES COMMISSION．

## At Edinburgh，the Twelfth Day of January Eightsen－hundred and Sixty－one Years．

WHEREAS，by an Act passed in the Twenty－ first and Twenty－second Years of Her Majeaty＇s Reign，Chapter Eighty－three，intituled ＇an Act to make Provision for the better Govern－ －ment and Discipline of the Universities of Scot－ －land，and improving wnd regulating the Conrse of ＇Study therein；and for the Union of the two －Universities and Colleges of Aberdeen，＇the Com－ missioners under the aaid Act are empowered，inter alia，subject to the Provisions thereof，to regulate by Ordinance the Powers，Jurisdictions，and Privi－ leges of Professors，and all other Members or Office－ Bearers in the several Universities of Scotland，as also of the Senatus Academicus and their Meet－ fing：the Commissioners statate and ordain，with reference to the University of Aberdeen，as fol－ lows：－

1．The Order of Precedence among the several Profesmors in the University of Aberdeen shall be regulated according to Seniority of Appoint－ ment es Profesoor，whether such Appointment shall have originally been made in King＇s College，or in Marischal College，or in the University of $A$ ber－ deen；and，in the Cape of Two or more Appoint－ zents being of the same Date，the Order of Pre－ cedence ehall be regulated according to the Order in which the Profeseorship are named in the Eighteenth Section of the ssid Act．
II．In the Absence of the Principal at $/$ fany Meeting of the Senatus Academicus，the Professor present，who is first in the Order of Precedence hereigabore provided，shall preside，with a delibe－ rative and a casting Vote．

## SCOTTISH UNIVERSITIES COMMISSION．

## At Edinburgh，the Twenty－sisth Day of January Eighteen Hundred and Sixty－one Years．

WHEREAS，by an Act passed in the Twenty－ first and Twenty－second Years of Her

Ordinance， No． 14. Majesty Reign，Chapter Eighty－three，intituled， －An Act to make Provision for the better Govern－ ＇ment and Discipline of the Universities of Scot－ ＇land，and improving and regulating the Course of －Study therein；and for the Union of the Two ＇Universities and Colleges of Aberdeen，＇the Com－ missioners under the said Act are empowered，inter alia，to make Rules for the Management and Ordering of the several Universities of Scotland， the Manner and Conditions in and under which Students shall be admitted thereto，the Course of Study and Manner of Teaching therein，the Manner of Examination，with the Qualifications，Appoint－ ment and Number of Examiners，and the Amount and Manner of their Remuneration，the granting of Degrees，whether in Arts，Divinity，Law，or Medi－ cine，and to provide that，in so far as shall be prac－ ticable，and，in the Opinion of the Commissioners， conducive to the Well－being of the Universities， and to the Advancement of Learning，the Course of Study，the Manner of Examination，and the Con－ ditions under which Degrees are to be conferred， shall be uniform in all the Universities of Scotland； and whereas the Commissioners of Her Majesty＇s Treasury are empowered by the aame Act to pay out of such Moneys as may be provided by Parlia－ ment for the Purpose，such Sums of Money as the Commissioners onder the Act shall recommend to be paid for，among other Purposes，that of pro－ viding Remuneration to the Examiners appointed in pursuance thereof：the Commissioners under the said Act atatute and ordain，with reference to the granting of Degrees in Arts in each of the said Universities，as follows：－

1．The Couree of Study necestary for the Degree of Master of Arts shall extend over Fonr Winter Sessions，and shall include Attendance for not less than Two Sessions on the Classes of Smudant Greek，and Mathematics respectively；\％ ance for not less than One Session on the
