

"Acts Amendment Act, 1860," or wholly or partially to exempt the Corporation from any of the provisions of those Acts or either of them, or to modify or alter the same, with reference to all or any of the objects of the Bill, and to vary or extinguish any rights or privileges thereunder, or under any other Act or Acts, letters-patent, charters, or otherwise.

IX. To alter, amend, or repeal all or some of the provisions of the Acts (local and personal), 57th George III., cap. 41, entitled "An Act for Lighting the City and Suburbs of Glasgow with Gas, and for other purposes relating thereto," 3rd George IV., cap. 80, entitled "An Act to enlarge and amend an Act of his late Majesty for Lighting the City and Suburbs of Glasgow with Gas," 6th George IV., cap. 35, entitled "An Act for enabling the Glasgow Gas Light Company to raise a further Sum of Money, and for other purposes relating thereto," 7th Geo. IV., cap. 38, entitled "An Act for enabling the Glasgow Gas Light Company to raise a further Sum of Money for the use of their Works, and for other purposes relating thereto," 20 and 21 Vict., cap. 35, "The Glasgow Gas Light Company's Act, 1857," and the 28th Vict., cap. 7, "The Glasgow Gas Light Company's Act, 1863," relating to the Glasgow Gas Light Company; and also the Acts (local and personal), 6 and 7 Victoria, cap. 58, entitled "An Act for the Better Supplying and Lighting with Gas the City and Suburbs of Glasgow and Places adjacent, and for other purposes relating thereto," 20 and 21 Victoria, cap. 80, "The Glasgow City and Suburban Gas Company's Act 1857," and the 28 Victoria, cap. 2, "The Glasgow City and Suburban Gas Company's Act, 1865," relating to the City and Suburban Gas Company of Glasgow, and any other Acts relating to those Companies; and "The Glasgow Police Act, 1867."

X. To alter, vary, or extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might prevent, impede, or interfere with any of the objects aforesaid being carried into effect, and to confer all other rights and privileges necessary or expedient for effecting the said objects, or in relation thereto.

Duplicate Plans describing the lands and houses to be taken compulsorily under the powers of the Bill and Books of Reference to the Plans, and a copy of this Notice as published in the *Edinburgh Gazette*, will, on or before the 30th day of November instant, be deposited for public inspection with the Principal Sheriff-Clerk of the County of Lanark, at his Office at Glasgow, and a copy of the said Plans, and Books of Reference will, with a copy of this Notice as published in the *Edinburgh Gazette*, on or before the said 30th day of November, 1868, be also deposited with the Schoolmaster, or if there be no Schoolmaster, with the Session-Clerk of the said Barony Parish of Glasgow, at the usual place of abode of such Schoolmaster or Session-Clerk.

Printed Copies of the intended Bill will be deposited in the Private Bill Office of the House of Commons, on or before the 23rd day of December next.

GLASGOW CORPORATION GAS,  
PURCHASE OF EXISTING GAS WORKS, &c.

Power to Corporation of Glasgow to Purchase by Agreement, and to the Glasgow Gas Light Company, and to the City and Suburban Gas Company of Glasgow, respectively, to Sell their Undertakings; Power to Corporation (1) to Maintain existing Gas Works, and Manufacture and Supply Gas within the City and Royal Burgh of Glasgow and the Suburbs thereof, and other Places included within the Existing Companies' Area of Distribution; (2) To Levy Rates and Rents for the Supply of Gas, and to alter Existing Rates and Rents; (3) To Levy Special Rates for Purposes of Bill within the Municipality and City and Royal Burgh of Glasgow; (4) To Borrow Money, and to Charge same on their Corporate Estates and Revenues, and on the Rates and Rents to arise under the Bill, and on the Property for the time being belonging to them; Dissolution and Winding-up of said Gas Companies; Incorporation, Repeal, or Amendment of Acts; and other Purposes.

NOTICE is Hereby Given, That application is intended to be made to Parliament in the ensuing Session by the Lord Provost, Magistrates, and Council of the City of Glasgow (hereinafter called the Corporation), for leave to bring in a Bill for the following, or some of the following, among other objects, powers, and purposes; that is to say—

I. To authorise and empower the Corporation to purchase, by agreement, the undertakings, or either of them, or any part of the respective undertakings of the Glasgow Gas Light Company and the City and Suburban Gas Company of Glasgow (hereinafter called the existing Companies), including all or any part of their Gas works, lands, property, estates, pipes, works, rights, powers, and privileges; and to authorise and empower the existing Companies respectively to sell to the Corporation their undertakings, or any portion or portions thereof which, by the Bill, they may be authorised to sell; and to prescribe the mode of settling, by arbitration or otherwise, the purchase money or compensation; and to vest the undertakings, or the parts thereof authorised to be purchased, in the Corporation; and to enable the Corporation to exercise all the rights and powers of the respective Companies in relation to their respective undertakings, or either of them, or part thereof so purchased.

II. To authorise agreements between the Corporation and the existing Companies, or either of them, for purchase by way of rent charge, permanent or terminable annuities, or otherwise.

III. To authorise the Corporation to alter and improve and maintain the works to be acquired as aforesaid, or any part of them; and to manufacture Gas and the several matters producible from the residual products arising or resulting from the manufacture of Gas, and generally to carry on the operations and works which are carried on by Corporations and Companies who manufacture and supply Gas for public and private lighting; and to supply Gas for lighting
