NOTIFICATION. Accounts and Finance, Fort William, the 21st February 1879, No. 955.—The following statement of accounts outstanding in the books of the late Government Agency, showing the names of the parties by whom the several accounts were opened and the deposits in Government

securities and cash remaining at credit of each, is published for general information.

Parties having claims to the balance of any of the said accounts should apply, within six months from this date, at the Office of the Comptroller-General, and produce proof in support of their claims.

The balance of each account to which no claim is preferred within six months will be carried to the credit of Government.
