To all the Local Authorities in Scotland having
 jurisdiction in terms of "The Public Health
 (Scotland) Act, 1867."

WHEREAS by the Act 30 and 31 Vict. c. 101, "Part III., for the Prevention and Mitigation of Diseases, under Order in Council," and by the 31st section of the said Act, it is enacted, that "Whenever any part of the United Kingdom appears to be threatened with or is affected by any formidable epidemic, endemic, or contagious disease, the Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, or any three or more of them (the Lord President of the Council, or one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, being one), may, by Order or Orders by them from time to time made, direct that the Provisions for the prevention of diseases contained in Part III. hereof be put in force in Scotland, or in such parts thereof, or in such places therein, as in such Order or Orders may be expressed, and may from time to time, as to all or any of the parts or places to which any such Order or Orders extend, and in like manner revoke or renew any such Order."

AND by an Order of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, bearing date the 21st day of July 1883, it is ordered, that "WHEREAS the United Kingdom appears to be threatened with a certain epidemic disease, that is to say, the Asiatic Cholera; AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision
