A^T the Court at St. James's, the 1st Day of June, 1763,

P R E S E N T, The K I N G's most Excellent Majesty in Council.

HEREAS by an Act made in the laft Seffion of Parliament, intituled, "An "Act for the further Improvement of " His Majesty's Revenue of Customs; " and for the Encouragement of Officers making " Seizures ; and for the Prevention of the clan-" define Running of Goods into any Part of His " Majefty's Dominions, it is, amongst other Things, Enacted, That for the more effectual Prevention of the infamous Practice of Smuggling, and for the better Encouragement of the Officers and Seamen of all fuch Ships and Vessels of War belonging to His Majesty, His Heirs, and Successors, who may be employed in preventing the clandestine Running of Goods on the Coasts of Great Britain and Ireland, and of the other Dominions and Colonies belonging to the Crown of Great Britain, One Moiety of the Nett Produce arifing by the Sale of Smuggling Vef-fels and prohibited Goods, which fhall be fo feized after the First Day of May, 1763, and condemned and fold according to Law, (the Charges whereof being first deducted) shall be vested in the faid Officers and Seamen ; and His Majefty is thereby empowered to caufe the fame to be divided amongst the faid Officers and Seamen, in fuch Proportions, and in fuch Manner, as His Majefty, His Heirs, and Succeffors, shall think fit to order and direct, by any Order or Orders of Council, or by any Proclamation or Proclamations, to be made or islued, from Time to Time, for that Purpole ; and His Majefty is likewife empowered by the faid Act, to make a Diffribution of any other Part of all and every the Seizure and Seizures that shall be made by fuch Officers and Seamen respectively; the Money arising by the Sale of which other Part is directed by the faid Act to be paid into the Exchequer. His Majesty, taking the fame into His Royal Consideration, is hereby pleased, purfuant to the Powers vefted in Him by the faid Act, and by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order, direct, and appoint, That the Moiety of Seizures, granted by the faid Act to the Officers and Seamen as aforefaid, be divided in the following Proportions; videlicet,

1ft, With Regard to Seizures made by the Officers and Men of Ships and Sloops of War.

To the Captain or Captains of any fuch Ships or Sloops, who shall be actually on Board at the Seizure of any Smuggling Veffel, or prohibited Goods, Three Eighth Parts, to be equally divided amongst them; To the Captains of Marines and Land Forces, Sea Lieutenants and Masters, on Board any fuch Ships or Sloops, One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongst them; To the Lieutenants and Quarter Masters of Marines, and Lieutenants, Ensigns, and Quarter Masters of Land Forces, Boatswain, Gunner, Purfer, Carpenter, Master's Mate, Surgeon, Pilot, and Chaplain, on Board any fuch Ships or Sloops, One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongst them; To the Midshipmen, Secretary to Flag Offi-

cers, Captain's Clerk, Mafter Sailmaker, Carpenter's Mates, Boatfwain's Mates, Gunner's Mates Mafter at Arms, Corporals, Yeomen of the Sheets, Coxfwain, Quarter Mafters, Quarter Mafters Mates, Surgeons Mates, Yeomen of the Powder Room, and Serjeants of Maines or Land Forces, on Board any fuch Ships or Sloops, One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongft them ; To the Trumpeters, Quarter Gunners, Carpenter's Crew, Steward, Cook, Armourer, Steward's Mate, Cook's Mate, Gunfmith, Cooper, Swabber, Ordinary Trumpeter. Barber, Able Seamen, Ordinary Seamen, and Marine or other Soldiers, and all other Perfons doing Dutt or affifting on Board any fuch Ships or Sloops. Two Eighth Parts, to be equally divided amongft them.

2d, With Regard to Selzures made by the Afficiers and Men of Cutters, commanded by Lieux nants.

To the Lieutenant commanding fuch Cutter, the shall be actually on Board at the Seizure of wy Smuggling Veffel, or prohibited Goods, One H If Part : To the Second Mafter and Pilot, or Mafter's Mate and the Midshipmen, on Board any such Cutter, One Eighth Part; the Second Mafter and Pilot, or Master's Mate, to have Two Third Parts thereof, and the Midshipman to have the Remainder . But if there should happen to be a Pilot Extraordinary on Board at the making of any fuch Seizure, the Second Master and Pilot, or Master's Mate, is, in that Cafe; to have One Moiety of the faid Eighth Part, and the other Moiety is to be equally divided between the Pilot extraordinary and Midshipman. To the Clerk and Steward, Boatswain's Mate, Gunner's Mate, Carpenter's Mate, and Surgeon's Mute, on Board any fuch Cutter, One Eighth Part ; To the Able Seamen, Ordinary Seamen, and all other Perfons, doing Duty and affifting on Board any fuch Cutter, Two Eighth Parts, to be equally divided amongst them.

3d, With Regard to Seizures made by Ships or Sloops of War in Conjunction with Cutters.

That in all fuch Cafes, the Moiety which is given to the Officers and Men who fhall make fuch Seizure; be divided into fo many equal Parts, or Shares; as there may be Ships or Sloops, and Cutters concerned therein, and that those Shares be diffributed to the Officers and Men of the Ships or Sloops, and Cutters, according to the aforegoing Proportions.

And His Majefty doth hereby further order, direft, and appoint, That in Cafe any Seizures shall be made in any of the Colonies Abroad, belonging to the Crown of Great Britain, by His Majesty's Ships or Vessel, being Part of the Squadron, or acting under the Orders of a Flag Officer, or a Commodore, with a Captain under him, such Flag Officer or Commodore, shall have One Fourth Part of the other Moiety of the faid Seizure, which is directed by Ast of Parliament to be paid into the Receipt of His Majesty's Exchequer : And in Case any Sta Captain, Inferior Commission or Warrant Sea Officers, belonging to any such Ship or Vessel, for whom any Shares of Seizures are hereby allowed, be abfent at the Time of making such Seizure, the Share of such Sea Captain, Inferior Commission or Warrant Sea Officer, shall be cast into the Shares hereby allowed
