Petersbourg, June 1. E R Imperial Majesty returns To-morrow from Czarskoe Selo, but it is supposed she will not remain long in Town.

Algiers, June 4. Yesterday Commo-dore Harrison, in the Centurion, failed from hence to Mahon, after Three Weeks Stay here. In the Evening, the Vessel bound for Portsmouh, having on board his Royal Highnels the Duke of York's Horles, put back to this Port, by reason of contrary Winds.

Copenbagen, June 18. On Sunday last this Court went into Mourning for Six Weeks for the late Princefs Dowager of East Friefland, who died on the 7th Inflant.

St. James's, June 26. The King has been pleafed to order Letters Patent to be passed under the Great Seal of the Kingdom of Ireland, containing a Grant unto Benjamin Barrington, Doctor in Divinity, of the Place and Dignity of Dean of Armagh, vacant by the Death of Anthony Cope, late Dean thereof.
