OUNT Malachowski, who was sent by his Polifh Majefty, to notify his Coronation to the Empress, left this Place on Friday laft, and he is foon to be fol-lowed by M. Soltikoff, who is appointed to go

to Warlaw to return the Compliment. Warlaw, April 10. The Bilhop of Cujavia

is to go, in a few Weeks, to Dantzig, to receive, in the King's Name, the Homage of that Town.

Florence, April 20. By Orders from Vienna to haften the Difpolitions for the Arrival of the Archduke, a great Number of Workmen of all Sorts are to be added to those employed at the Palace.

The Marquife Riccardi, and Madame Antinori, two Widow Ladies here, have been appointed to receive the Archdutchels at the Place the debarks at, to attend her to Infpruck, and from thence to Florence.

Berlin, April 20. On Thursday last M. de Braniski, Envoy Extraordinary from the King of Poland, had his Audience of Leave of the King of Pruffia at Sans Souci, where his Pruffian Majesty still continues. Last Night there was a very numerous and fplendid Court, and afterwards a grand Supper in the Queen of Pruffia's Apartment.

Berlin, April 23. Laft Sunday M. de Braniski, Envoy Extraordinary from the King of Poland, had his Audience of Leave of the Queen of Pruffia and the Reft of the Royal Family; and propofes to fet out, on his Return to Warsaw, in a few Days.

The Transport, with Part Hague, April 26. of the Dutch Troops from the Berbices, which was miffing, is got lafe into the lfle of Rhé.

St. James's, April 26, 1765.

Whereas it has been humbly represented to the King. That, on Tuefday the 16th Day of this Inftant April, early in the Morning, James Knight, of Walham Green, in the Parish of Fulham, in the County of Middlefex, (being, as is supposed, on his Return Home from London) was found robbed, and barbaroufly murdered by a Pifiol Shot, (which Shot has been fince extracted from him) near a House in the Parish of Chelsea, known by the Name, or Sign, of the Cow and Calves, in the High Road between Knightforidge and Little Chelfea; and that the faid Robbery, and barbarous Murder, were committed by fome Perfon or Perfons unknown: His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in the faid horrid Crimes, is, bereby, pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon to any One of them who shall discover his Accomplice, or Accomplices in the faid Fasts, (except the Perfon who

actually committed the faid Murder) fo that be, she or they, may be apprehended and convicted thereo DUNK HALIFAX.

And, as a further Encouragement, the Church-Wardens, and other the Inhabitants of the Parish of Ghelsea, bave ordered, and do bereby promife, a Reward of FIFTY POUNDS, to any Perfon or Perfons making fuch Discovery as aforefaid, or who shall give such Notice to Sir John Fielding as may be the Means of making such Discovery, (except as above excepted) to be paid by Mr. John Green, of the said Parish; upon
